2. The post of LDAs in the Sectt, and various Directorates shall be filled from a merit list prepared on the basis of combined competitive examination to which those already in Govt, service as well as fresh candidates shall be admitted. The educational qualification in respect of fresh entrants shall be Pre-University/Higher Secondary School Leaving Certificate while no minimum qualification shall be prescribed for those already Government service. The recruitment test shall be conducted in the following subjects.
