ISSUED BY HEADS OF DEPARTMENT AND HIGH COURT

[NOTIFICATION

No. MAP. 13/97/73/65, the 7th. March, 1975. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution read with the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/11/71-HMT-(ii) dated the 21st. Jan., 1972 the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the posts of Superintendent (Non-gazetted) UDA, Accountant, UDA-cum-Accountant, Cashier, LDA and LDA-cum-Typist in the Directorates as laid down in the Schedule hereto annexed.

1. **Short title** (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Directorates (Class III posts) Recruitment Rules, 1975.

2. **Initial Recruitment** For initial recruitments, the posts of Superintendents, UDAs in the Directorates, shall be filled.

(a) from a Common list drawn up on the basis of total length of clerical service of all the ministerial servants working in the District level Offices, including that of the erstwhile Mizo District Council.

(b) by drawing suitable officials working in the Secretariat and Directorates of Assam and other Governments.

2. The post of LDAs in the Sectt. and various Directorates shall be filled from a merit list prepared on the basis of combined competitive examination to which those already in Govt. service as well as fresh candidates shall be admitted. The educational qualification in respect of fresh entrants shall be Pre-University/Higher Secondary School Leaving Certificate while no minimum qualification shall be prescribed for those already Government service. The recruitment test shall be conducted in the following subjects.

Subject	Time allotted	Total marks.
1) General English & Essay	2 hours	150
2) General Knowledge	1½ hours	100
3) Viva-voce.	--	50

3. Period of probation will be for 2 (two) years.

3. **Number of post, Classification and scale of pay** The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule aforesaid.

4. **Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualification** The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

5. **Disqualification** No person,
 (a) who, has entered into or contracted marriage with a person having a spouse living, OR
 (b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Administrator may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of rule.

6. **Training and Departmental examination** Every Government servant shall undergo such training or pass such departmental examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

7. **Power to relax** Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons,

8. Reservation other concessions.

Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.

9. Repeal and Saving

All Rules pertaining to these posts, framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Government of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT (ii) dated 21. 1. 72 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
