- Application. These Rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto annexed.
- 3. Number of post. The number of the said posts, their classification and the classification and scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in and scale of pay
   Columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule aforesaid.
- 4. Method of rectt The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating age limit and to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 other qualification of the said Schedule.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Gentral Goyt, or Goyt, of Mizoram from time to time. 5.
