Notification No. FTX. 2/72/66 dated 16-10-74, the Governor of Assam after being satisfied that it is necessary so to do in the public interest hereby directs, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (5) of Section 8 of the Central Sales Tax Act, 1956 (Act 74 of 1956) that no taxes under the aforesaid Act shall be payable upto 30-9-75 with effect from 1-4-75 by any registered dealer having his place of business in the State of Assam in respect of sales by him from any such place of business of any goods in course of interstate trade or commerce to any dealer in the Union Territories of Arunachal Pradesh and Mizoram.

## OFFICE MEMORANDUM

No.HM (M). 8/72/244. (A) the 14th March 1975. The erstwhile Mizo District Council on 9.7.1970 passed a resolution to the effect that the spelling of "Aijal" should in future be written "Aizawl" for correct spelling and pronunciation and

similarly "Lungleh" should also be written "Lunglei" in future. Falling in line with the wishes of the erstwhile District Council, Government issued a Notification in this regard vide No. Home. 1/72/15 dt. 10.2.1972 and published in the Mizoram Gazette dt. 18.2.1972. Government had taken further action and with the concurrence of Survey of India and Govt. of India to the changes of spelling "Aijal" into "Aizawl" and "Lungleh" into "Lunglei" issued further Notifications under this Deptt. letter No. HM (M). 8/72/211 dated 3.4.1974. HM (M). 8/72/236 dated 12.8.1974 and HM (M) 8/72/241 dated 25.9.1974.

It is noticed that some Departments are still using "Aijal" instead of "Aizawl" and "Lungleh" instead of "Lunglei" in the sign boards etc. in violation of Government decision.

It is hereby reiterated that the correct spellings of "Aizawl" and "Lunglei" should strictly be followed in all official correspondences and Sign Boards by all concerned.

[No. MAP/B/14/72-73/10 the 19th. March, 1975. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution read with the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/11/71-HMT-(ii) dated the 21st. Jan., 1972 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the posts of Senior Drivers, Junior Drivers/Despatch Rider, Handyman in various offices under Govt. of Mizoram.

1. **Short title and commencement.** These Rule may be called the Mizoram Drivers, Handyman etc., Recruitment Rules, 1975.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Application.** These Rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto annexed.
3. **Number of post, Classification and scale of pay** The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule aforesaid.
4. **Method of rectt age limit and other qualification** The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

5. **Dissqualification.** No person,  
 (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, OR  
 (b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.  
 Provided that the Administrator may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
6. **Training and Departmental examination** Every Government servant shall undergo such training or pass such departmental examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
7. **Power to relax** Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons,
8. **Reservation of other concessions.** Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time regard.
9. **Repeal and Saving** All Rules pertaining to these posts, framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Government of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14,21/71-HMT (ii) dated 21. 1. 72 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
