**3. Number of Posts, classification and scale of Pay.**

The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule aforesaid.

**4. Method of recr. age limit and other qualification**

The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recr. may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other Special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

**5. Disqualification** No person :

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, OR
- (b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Administrator may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there other ground for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

**Training and Departmental Examination**

Every Government servant shall undergo such training or pass such departmental examinations as may be prescribed from time to time.

**7. Power to relax.**

Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and on reasons to be recorded in writing, relax



any of provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

**8. Reservation other concessions**

Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Tribes Scheduled Castes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.

**9. Repeal and Saving**

All rules pertaining to these posts, framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Govt. of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT (ii) dt. 21. 1. 72 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
