APPENDIX 'A'

The rates of compensation for trees, plants, crops etc. etc. be fixed by the Committee. All compensation is directly related to market value of property and market prices of commodities situated in urban towns and agricultural produce in exporting centres or within easy access of lines of communications like rail head and major roads and markets cannot be put at par with properties situated elsewhere. It may not be equitable or even practicable to fix one rate for the whole of Mizoram. The factors that have to be taken into account for fixing compensations may be already detailed in some rules either in P.W.D. code or in the Land Revenue Rules. These rules, if any may be consulted.

When fixing compensation for trees, etc. etc. the annual income from fruit-bearing trees may also be considered.

In case of compensation for land, trees, Gardens, Fountains, Buildings and vehicles etc. etc. the Department concerned will best know the procedure to be followed in fixing/assessing the rates.
