Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram has been satisfied that the administration of the Chakma Autonomous District Council has not been running in accordance with the requirements of the Constitution thereby causing instability in the Executive Committee and improper utilisation of the funds which has given rise to such circumstance that it is imperative to have a through probe done into the affairs and the administration of the Council;

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers vested unto him under provisions of Paragraph 14 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram is pleased to appoint a One-Man-Enquiry-Commission consisting of Shri S.R. Sharma, I.A.S. Deputy Commissioner, Chhimtuipui District.

The Commission shall follow the normal procedure for enquiries, including examination of records and witnessess, acceptance and consideration of memoranda as may be submitted by any person or persons and shall also hold on the sportinspections and verifications as may be required.

The Commission shall submit its report and recommendations as early as possible and in no case later than 45 days from the date of this notification to the Administrator as required under Paragraph 16 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution, and may, inter alia, recommend dissolution of the Council together with reasons therefore.

The enquiry shall be carried out under the following terms of reference:—

1. Whether administration of the Council have been carried out in accordance with the Rules governing the transaction of business of the District Councils?

- 2. Whether funds placed at the disposal of the Council both in non-plan and plan-sectors have been properly utilised? If yes, how and what are the concrete and constructive instances of utilisations and achievements! If not, why not? Has there been of misuse or misappropriation of funds? Give concrete instances and mention and name the person or persons responsible for such misuse.
- 3. What is the total strength of the members of the staff, including officers under the District Council? Is the number of the officers and the staff disproportionate to the quantum of work and the outlay? If so how? Recommend reduction or increase of the number of the staff.
- 4. Whether the recruitment of the staff has been made with due regard to qualifications and experience or appointments have been made indiscreminately without regard to qualifications etc. or the actual requirements of works? Are there palpacle instances of nepotism and favoutism in matters of recruitments?
- 5. Whether financial rules have been strictly followed in matters of utilisation of funds? If not, have there been misutilisation of funds due to corrupt practices, bribary illegal gratification etc.
- 6. Are records of official tours undertaken by the functionaries of the Council and their officers have been maintained? If so, what is the reason of heavy expenditure on TA/DA? Have there been instances of take tours and misappropriation of public funds on that account? If so who are the persons responsible?
- 7. Have the members been subject to any undesirable pleasures or threats? Have some of them made forced constributions under threats etc.
- 8. In the overall interest of the people, is it necessary to dissolve the Countries take other measures that are recommended for improvement of the administration?
- 9. The Commission may recommend any special or particular scheme for improvement of the administration and accelerated development of the area.
- 10. Any other matter relevant under the circumstances and considered necessary in the interest of administration.
