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ANNEXURE 'A'

DESCRIPTION OF AIZAWL TOWN BOUNDARY

- Starting Point** : Taking the 4th mile stone along Aizawl-Dartlang road as Starting Point where Boundary Pillar No. 1 is fixed the boundary runs along the road towards Bawngkawn till it meets a stream called Project Lui the boundary follows up stream of this Lui at a distance of 500ft. where Boundary Pillar No. 2 is fixed; thence the boundary runs eastwards at a constant distance of 50ft. parallel to the Aizawl-Lunglei road till it meets Lianzova's land near Kelpu Veng where Boundary Pillar No. 3 is fixed.
- Eastern Side** : From Boundary Pillar No. 3 the boundary follows down a stream that takes its source from the convoy ground till it meets Met li i; thence the boundary runs downstream of Mutianu till it meets Berawlui where Boundary Pillar No. 4 is fixed; thence the boundary runs upstream of Berawlui crossing Aizawl-Lunglei road at 9 m.p. where Pillar No. 5 is fixed till it meets the saddle between Beraw and Zokhawsang where Boundary Pillar No. 6 is fixed. From Boundary Pillar No. 6 the boundary runs downstream of Lungyai lui in westerly direction which takes its source from the saddle till it meets Chitelui where Boundary Pillar No. 7 is fixed; thence the boundary runs downstream of Chitelui to its confluence with Sibpuini where Boundary Pillar No. 8 is fixed.
- Southern Side** : From Boundary Pillar No. 8 the boundary runs upstream of Sibpuilui till it meets the stream called Ngaizellui; thence the boundary follows Ngaizellui till it meets the Aizawl-Thenzawl road where Pillar No. 9 is fixed; thence the boundary follows the Aizawl-Thenzawl road in southerly direction till it meets Saikhmakawn where (Melthum Village) Reserve Boundary Pillar was fixed, and where Boundary Pillar No. 10 is fixed. From Boundary Pillar No. 10 the boundary runs in a straight line in westerly direction upto Submakawn water point; thence the boundary runs downstream of the Tukizelhi called Ramjilhi till it meets a dry stream which takes its source from Hridaikawn on Thanzawl-Lunglei road.
- Western Side** : Thence the boundary runs upstream of the dry stream till it meets Hridaikawn where Boundary Pillar No. 11 is fixed; thence the boundary follows down a numerous streamlet of

Sakhsishui till it meets Sakhsih; thence the boundary runs upstream of Sakhsih till it meets a dry stream called Pa Paila's huan lau; thence the boundary runs upstream of this dry stream till it meets Chavlibun-Kawa near Fu Lai's Garden where Pillar No. 12 is fixed. From Boundary Pillar No. 12 the boundary runs along the foot path of Mission Vong in a northwesterly direction till it meets Sedaikawn where Boundary Pillar No. 13 is fixed. From Boundary Pillar No. 13 the boundary runs downstream of a streamlet of Vailui till it meets Vailui; thence the boundary runs downstream of Vailui till it meets the point where Thawngphai foot road crosses the Vailui where Boundary Pillar No. 14 is fixed; thence the boundary runs in northwesterly direction along the foot path upto a distance of 1½ km from Boundary Pillar 14 where Boundary Pillar No. 15 is fixed; thence the boundary line runs in a straight line till it meets the confluence of Tuithum river and Kawzaului between Luangmual and Tanhril; thence the boundary runs upstream of Kawzaul stream till it meets the saddle between Luangmual and Tanhril road where Boundary Pillar No. 16 is fixed thence the boundary runs down to Mehga stream which takes its source from the saddle and crosses Sairang road where Boundary Pillar No. 17 is fixed till it meets Sairang-Lui.

Northern Side : Thence the boundary runs upstream of Sairanglui, to its source at mile stone No. 4 on Aizawl-Durtlang road, where it meets the Boundary Pillar No. 1.

ANNEXURE 'B'

DESCRIPTION OF CHAMPHAI TOWN BOUNDARY.

Starting from the tunnel of Aizawl - Champhai Border road the boundary shall run up the small stream to its source, crossing Sainuna's Wet Rice Cultivation; thence up the stream of Thingherh to its source, thence to the dale of Thingherh. From this point the boundary shall run northerly along the stream to Awmpoi Phaihar; thence along the Phaihar and strikes the junction of Zote and Ruanlang motor roads, thence along the Zote road and strikes Thangsum kawng at Thawblawm Chhokin Kawr; thence in a straight line northerly to Aitea Phaihar and then strikes a stream (Kawng) thence up this stream to its source and strikes the middle of the dale

(Kawn) of Thingsthliah. From this point the boundary shall run in westerly direction down a small stream to its junction with Keilongthlahui; thence up the Keilongthlahui to its source and to its junction with Fakawthui and then along the Sakawpu kawn up to the Pastor Pukui. Running along Pastor Pukui to a point called Chhebrekawn. From this point the boundary shall run in a straight line southwards along the bridge of cliff till it strike Lamlian Hui. Running along Lamlian Hui and strikes Y.M.A. road near Border road; thence as towards along the Y.M.A. road and thence strikes the point where the boundary started running at the tunnel of the Border Road.

ANNEXURE 'C'

DESCRIPTION OF LUNGLEI TOWN BOUNDARY

1. All lands lying between Sethluokawn in the South and Zotei Veng in the north that is to say, all lands falling within the Village Council Jurisdiction of Lunglawn, Chandmay, Ralsiveng, Bawngveng, Bazar Veng and Zotieng extending one KM on both sides of the Aizawl—Lunglei road and Lunglei—Thenzawl road.
2. All inhabited area, not included but falling within the Village Council's Jurisdiction, stated in (1) above.]

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 372 of the Constitution read with the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 141171-HM-3-3 dated the 21st. Jan., 1972 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the posts of Statistical Officer in the Dept. of Economics and Statistics, Govt. of Mizoram. Namely :

1. **Short title and commencement.** These Rule may be called the Mizoram Economics and Statistics (Class III posts) Recruitment Rules, 1973.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Application.** These Rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto annexed.
3. **Number of post, Classification and scale of pay** The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule aforesaid.
4. **Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualification** The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 7 of the said Schedule.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

5. **Disqualification.** No person,
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, OR
 - (b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Administrator may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Training and Departmental examination** Every Government servant shall undergo such training or pass such departmental examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
7. **Power to relax** Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
8. **Reservation other concessions.** Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
9. **Repeal and Saving** All Rules pertaining to these posts, framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Government of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HM I (ii) dated 21. 1. 72 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
