The Lt. Governor of Mizoram is pleased to create the following Forest Ranges under Forest Department Mizoram.

EAST

From the said village the boundary runs in south-western direction along the said PWD road upto village Biate (Point No. 4) then the boundary takes a turn towards south-east and runs along the said road upto the river Khawchhaktuipui and then along the said river downstream upto where it meets the International Boundary of Burma and India (Mizoram) (Point No. 5) then it goes along the said International Boundary towards west upto where it meets the northern boundary of Lunglei District (point No. 6).

SOUTH

From the above point the boundary follows the northern boundary of Lunglei District till it meets the river Tlawng on the west (Point No. 7).

WEST

Then the boundary follows the river Tlawng down-stream upto the starting point, i. e. the point fixed diametrically opposite to west of Village Thiak (Point No 8).

			EAST Then it follows the Inter State Boundary of Mizoram and Manipur, and then follows the International Boundary of Burma and India (Mizoram) upto the mouth of river Tuisa (Point No. 3) thereafter the boundary follows the same river upstream upto its source near the village Tuichawng (Point No. 4).	

SOUTH

Then the boundary goes along a straight line to be demarcated due west up to the river Tuivai and then it follows the same river in the north-western direction still it meets the common an existing boundary of Kolasib and Champhai Range (Point No. 5). Then the boundary runs in southerly direction for a distance of 60 chains till it meets the north-eastern corner of Aizawl Range (Point No.6) thereafter the boundary runs in westerly along the northern boundary of existing Aizawl Range, till it meets the river Tuival (Point No.7).

WEST

Thence the boundary follows the river Tuival downstream upto the point where it meets the southern boundary of Inner Line Reserve at the starting point (Point No. 1).

Approx. Area 1617.40 Sq.Km.

The boundary starts from a point fixed on the Inter-State Boundary between Tripura and Mizoram, west of eastern source of the river Langkhaih (Point No. 1) and runs along a straight line to be demarcated due east and meets the river Tut above the village Zotlang (old village) (Point No. 2).

SOUTH

Then the boundary follows the northern boundary of Lunglei District till it meets the International boundary of Bangladesh and India (Mizoram) (Point No. 4).

WEST

Then the boundary follows the International Boundary of Bangladesh and India (Mizoram) in northern direction upto 32 Km, and then it follows the Inter-State boundary of Tripura and Mizoram in the same direction till it meets the starting point (Point No. 1).

Subj : Dissolution of Bilkhawthlr Fishery Coop : Society Registration
No A-4/60-61 of 22nd April, 1961.

Whereas I am of opinion as the result of an Inspection held into the constitution working and financial condition of the **Bilkhawthlr Fishery Coop : Society Ltd.** Under Section 61 of the Assam Co-operative Societies Act, 1949 (Act I of 1950) that the Society ought to be dissolved.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 65 of the Assam Cooperative Societies Act 1949 (Act I of 1950) I hereby cancel the registration of the said Society.

Further in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (1) of Section 66 of the Act I of 1950, I hereby appointed the Liquidator of Co-operative Societies, Mizoram, Aizawl to be liquidator of the said Society.

All claims against dissolved Society must be submitted to the liquidator within two months of the publication of this notice.
