Subj: Dissolution of the youth Companies 'A' (Phulphui) Trading C.S. Ltd
Registration No. A 157-58 of 29-5-1957

Whereas I am of opinion as the result of an inspection held into the constitution working and financial condition of the youth Companies 'A' (Phulphui) Trading Co-op. Society Ltd. under section 61 of the Assam Co-operative Societies Act 1949 (Act I of 1950) that the Society ought to be dissolved.

2nd. Class Master's Degree with Honours at Graduate level in the subject concerned.

Desirable (i) Three years experience of teaching Degree classes in a recognised College.

(ii) Experience of organising Sports, Games and other curricular activities.

3. Candidates must be in good mental and physical health and free from physical defects.

4. Candidates should not be less than 18 years and or more than 30 years of age on 1st January, 1976. The upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes Tribes. There is no age limit for persons already in Government service.

5. Candidates should submit their applications in plain paper giving full particulars, such as full name, address, age experience etc. and full detail of their

academic qualifications and examinations passed from Matriculation up to the Law-
 ting Division Class obtained for the various examinations supported by attested
 copies of Certificates and Mark sheets in respect of each, the year of passing such
 examinations with the names of Institutions concerned should also be mentioned.
