No. the \_\_\_\_\_ In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution read with the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/11/71-HMT-(ii) dated the 21st January, 1972 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the posts of Jail Warder under Jail Deptt., Govt. of Mizoram, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement. (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Jails Deptt. (Group 'D' Posts) Recruitment Rules 1978.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
2. Application. These Rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the schedule hereto annexed.
3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay. The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto and shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Scheduled aforesaid.

4. Method of rectt. age limit and other qualification. The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 13 of the said scheduled.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct rectt. may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

5. Disqualification. No person :  
 (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living.  
 or  
 (b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Administrator may, is satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Training and Departmental Examination. Every Govt. servant shall undergo such training or pass such departmental examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

7. Power to relax. Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of person.

8. Reservation other concessions. Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.

9. Repeal and Saving : All Rules pertaining to these post, framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Govt. of Assam and were in force in the estwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in persuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT-(ii) dated 21.1.72 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action under the rules so repealed or under any general deemed to have been made, done or taken the corresponding provisions of these rules.

- (1) Simplify, streamline and rationalise the functions of all organisation and agencies witherto engaged in the investigation identification, promotion and management of Small Scale and Village Industries in the selected of Districts of Union Territory with the ultimate aim to cover all Districts in cause of time.
- (2) Formulate and ensure effective implementation of the District Industries Centres Programme Sponsored by Government of India in the various Districts of the Union Territory.

- (4) Select all staff provided for appointment in various District Industries Centres and ensure their appointment and placement within the time schedule prescribe by Government of India.
- (5) Select sites, prepare building plans and ensure early creation of all physical facilities needed for smoot functioning of the District Industries Centres.



(6) Provide guide-lines to all District Industries Centres regarding "work programme" and accord approves to final plans prepared by them. In this regard, secure services of any suitable agency from inside or outside the Union Territory, for timely achievement of the objectifes.

(7) Advise the U.T. Government regarding the budgetting allocation from the U.T. Plan/Non-Plan to be made in respect of various District Industries Centres, for effective utilisation of resources. Secure cental assistance from various Boads Commissions, Financing Instittutions etc. for augmenting the resources in the U.T. Plan.

(8) Review and monitor the programme of work undertaken by each District Industries Centre and evaluate specific economic and social gains derieved out of the programme furnist periodical reports on the above to the U.T. Government and the Government of India.

(9) Keep abreast of similar effoils being undentaken in various neighbouring States and Union Territories and disgeminate the benefits thus derived, to the advantage of the District Industries Centre of the U.Ts.

#### DURATION

The State Level Committee will remain in force for a periods of two years from the date of its formation or until further orders whichever is earlier.

#### FREQUENCY

The Committee should normally hold at last six meetings in a financial year.

#### POWERS TO CO-OPT.

The Chairman is authorised to Co-opt. any official/expert of a Government or Quousei- Govt. Organisation, to the Committee for any specific meeting.

#### QUARUM

One third of the total member of members including the Chairman will form the quarum for any meeting of the Committee. A clear notice of 7 (seven) da y should normally be issued for holding any meeting of the Committee.

**II - TERMS OF REFERENCE :**

- a) To take all preliminary steps for starting the Politechnic classes from July, 1978.
- b) To make arrangement of hostel facilities for at least 50% of the student strength in the first year and look after all student welfare problems. To make decision regarding any disciplinary action to be taken against students.
- c) To conduct selection of all non-teaching staff and recommend to the Director of Education for approval.
- d) To advise the Principal on engagement of part-time teaching staff from local sources.
- e) To make arrangement of temporary accommodation of class-room, laboratory and Drawing class facilities for students.
- f) To advise and assist the Govt. on the development of site, construction of various buildings and other ancillary requirements like water and power supply, transport facilities etc for the permanent campus of the Politechnic.
- g) To advise the Principal on selection of students for admission into the Politechnic.
- h) To advise and assist the Govt. on any other matter related with the smooth running of the curricular programme of the Politechnic.
