## ORDER

No. MAP. 57/73/152, the 21st June, '78. Whereas an order placing Shri B.Hlychho, P.A. & A'D.C., Tuipang under suspension was made by the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Mizoram on 30.10.1973 assued vide Government No. MAP. 57/73/9 dated 30.10 1973.

And whereas the disciplinary authority is satisfied that the Officer has violated the provisions of Rules 3(1) of the Central Civil Service (Conduct) Rules, 1964.

Now, therefore, the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Mizoram in exercise of the powers conferred by Rule 12 read with Rule 16 of the C.C.S. (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rule, 1965 awards minor penalty inflicting the Officer to recover the full amount of the Govt. lost money amounting to Rs. 4035.57p (Rupees four thousand thirty five & paise fifty seven) only from his pay on condition that the said recovery at a time shall not exceed \( \frac{1}{2} \) of his basic pay and should not be spread over a period of more than 3 years. The recovery should not exceed one year basic pay.

The Lt. Governor is further pleased to revoke the order of suspension forthwith in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (c) of sub-rule (5) of Rule 10 of the C.C.S. (CC & A) Rules 1965.

An order regarding the guantum of pay and allowances to be paid and the manner how to treat the period of suspension shall be issued separately.
