a) To advise the Mizoram Administration from time to time on Legislative and administrative measures necessary for moving as far possible to economic and social injustice, disabilities and discriminations to which women are subjected;

b) To advise ways and means of enabling women to break through absolute restraints;

c) To enable women to assert inherent right to equality so that every woman is enabled to develop her gifts/capabilities and make her contribution to the nation, and;

d) To review the progress of implementation of programmes designed in pursuance thereof.

Steering Committee will be set up on the recommendation of this Committee.

The term of membership will be for a period of one year. Non-Official members will be entitled to TA/DA as admissible to Class/Grade I Officers of Mizoram administration.
