ORDER

No. MAP. 105/73-A/29, the 1st June, 1979. Whereas a disciplinary proceeding against Shri S.L. Gupta, S.D.O. (Sadar), Aizawl is contemplated.

Now, therefore, the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Mizoram in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-rule (1) of Rule 10 of the Central Civil Service (Classification Control and appeal) rules 1965 hereby place the said Shri S.L. Gupta, under suspension with immediate effect.
