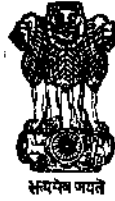

The new Mizoram House is situated at a distance of about 1 kilometre from the previous Mizoram House at Defence Colony and is comparatively nearer to the South Extension Market but is slightly away from the main Ring Road. It is also close to the Institute of All Indian Medical Sciences. It is a three storeyed building having 12 rooms including a hall, 2 servant rooms, 1 barsati and 1 basement. The new House is bigger and more spacious than the previous one.
