SUGGESTION FOR THE GUIDANCE OF STANDING COMMITTEE FOR ORGANISING COLLECTIONS ON THE FLAG DAY

The aid of all the suggestions given below is to bumper collections for the Flag day and all planning should be with this particular object in view,

- 2. It is felt that while one day in the year may be nominated as the Armed Forces Flag Day, is may not be organisationally possible to the arrange all collections effectively on that day alone. It is, therefore, necessary to plan in advance at a high enough level in the State and at Districts.
- (a) The Detailed steps that have to be taken to decentralise the tisk of making collections effectively.

- (b) Specifying the days or period or days over which intensive effects would be made to make colections;
- (c) The special steps that may have to be taken to ensure active co-operation of the authorities employing large number of persons or of places where large number of persons come daily.

SUGGESTIONS

- (i) State/District Committees for Flag Day Collections should carefully scruttaise that requirement of token and car flag to elsure that the demands are commensurate with the population.
- (ii) One sure way of stepping up collections is to sell large number of flags every year. For this purpose endeavours may be made to contact every potential do for both in uro an and rural areas.
- (iji) The Managements of big industrial and other concerns may be made special requests to organise callections through their own agencies in their concerns and remit the amount to the State Government asset their collection/ contribution to the FLAG DAY FUND.
- (iv) Commercial concerns and business houses of repute may be asked to donate generously, apart from individual donations.
- (v) Collections may be organised at railway stations, Post Offices marketing places, cinema houses, but stands and where people gather in large numbers.
- (vi) As majority of the population reside in villages, special attention may be given to collecting donations from rural areas through local. Revenue and Community. Project Staff.
- (vii) Flying Clubs, where stationed, may be requested to stage acrobatias in aid of the FLAG DAY FUND.
- (viii) Race Clubs, Sports Organisations, etc., may be approached to larrange special levents in aid of the Fund.
- (ix) Managements of Hotels/Rest ioralits, etc., may be instructed to organise special balls/enter-tainments in aid, or partially aid of the Fand.
- (x) Charity shows and other forms of entertainment may be held during the year to raise funds in aid of the Flag Day Fund.
- (xi) Flag Day must be given good publicity. Governor and Chief Ministers may be requested to issue appeals to public for generous donations.
- (xii) Cinema slides publicising the advent of the Flag Day may be exhibited for one week before its observance.
- (xiii) Important Establishments and installations of the Armed Forces where stationed may be contracted for assistance and the services of the National Cadet Corps may be utilised. Collections may be organised in close collaboration with the local Military Commander who have instructions to extend the maximum co-operation in making these collections a success.
- (xiv) Effective neasures should be taken to prevent leakage of collections as well as distribution of flags by authorise as well as distribution of flags by unauthorised persons. Unused flags may be described by burning in the presence of a Gazetted Officer and a Certificate giving burnber of such flags furnished to the Secretary, ISS & A. Board, Ministry of Defence, New Delhi.
- (xv) The amount collected should be remitted by Cheque /Bank drafts drawn in favour of the 'FLAG DAY FUND' and forwarded to the Secretary, Flag Day Fund C/o ISS & A Board, Ministry of Defence, Maulana Azad Road, DH PO New Dethi-110011.
