The Terms of reference are :—

- (1) Simplify, streamline and rationalise the functions of all organisations and agencies hitherto engaged in the investigation, promotion and management of Small Scale and Village Industries in the District.
- (2) Formulate and ensure effective implementation of the DIC programme sponsored by Government in the District.
- (3) Initiate all activities concerning establishment of the District Industries Centre and advise the Government regarding requirement of resources, personnel and infrastructural needs.

- (4) Select sites, prepare building plans and ensure early creation of all physical facilities needed for smooth functioning of the District Industries Centres.
- (5) Provide guide-lines to the District Industries Centre regarding "Work-Programme" and accord approval to plans prepared by them. In this regard, secure services of any suitable agency from inside or outside the Union Territory, for timely achievement the objectives.
- (6) Advise the Government regarding the budget allocation from the Plan/Non-Plan to be made in respect of the District Industries Centre for effective utilisation of resources. Secure central assistance from various Boards, Commissions, Financing Institutions etc. for augmenting the resources in the U.T. Plan.
- (7) Review and monitoring the programme of work undertaken by the District Industries Centre and evaluate specific economic and social gains derived out of the programme. Furnish periodical reports on the above to the Government.
- (8) Keep abreast of similar efforts being undertaken in the neighbouring Districts of the Union Territory and avail of the benefits thus derived to the advantage of the District Industries Centre.
- (9) No T.A/D.A. for attending this meeting will be given to the Non-Official Members.

DURATION

The District Committee will remain in force for a period of two years from the date of its formulation or until further orders whichever is earlier. In the case of MP/MLAs, they will cease to be members as and when they vacate their offices.

FREQUENCY

The Committee should normally hold at least six meetings in a financial year.

POWERS TO CO-OPT.

The Chairman is authorised to co-opt. any official/expert of Government or quasi-Government organisation, to the Committee for any specific meeting.

QUORUM

One third of the total member/members including the Chairman will form the Quorum for any meeting of the Committee. A clear notice of 7 (seven) days should normally be issued for holding any meeting of the Committee.
