- 1. These Rules may be called the Mizoram Education Department, (Class-II posts) Recruitment Rules, 1973.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

These Rules shall apply to the posts specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto annexed.

The number of the posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached there to shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule aforesaid.

The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

Provided that the upper age limit pres? cribed for direct rectt. may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Schedule Castes, the Schedule Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

5. Disqualification.

- 6. Training and Departmental Examination.
- 7. Power to relax.

8. Reservation other concessions

9. Repeal and Saving

No person:

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having spouse living CR. (b) Who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Administrator may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there other ground for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rules.

Every Government servant shall undergo such training or pass such departmental examination as may be prescribe from time to time.

Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.

All Rules pertaining to these posts, frammed by the Governor of Assam or by the Govt. of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71—HMT(ii) dated 21.1.72 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions these rules.
