The function of the Committee shall be:—

- a) To scrutinise the applications and the approved plan and estimates and to recommend to the Govt. the grant of Rehabilitation loan as per terms and conditions in respect of damages occurred during 1966 disturbances in Aizawl town areas (Bara Bazar & Khatla Bazar areas).
- b) To suggest quantum of loan for each individual case to the Government for reconstruction of stall/shop/buildings and loss of properties as the case may be.
- c) To recommend to the Government the pattern of buildings to be constructed with the loan money.
