RESOLUTIONS, ORDERS, NOTIFICATIONS etc. ISSUED BY HEADS OF DEPTT. AND HIGH COURT.

NOTIFICATION

No. FE-60/74-75/36-41 the 10.4.1975. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/11/71-HMT-(ii) dated the 21st January, 1972 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the posts of Asstt. Headmaster of High School, Asstt. Teacher of High School, Headmaster, M.E. School etc. in the Education Department, Govt. of Mizoram, namely :--

I. Short title and (1) Mizoram Education Departments (Class III posts Reccommencement ruitment Rules, 1975.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

- 2. Application. These Rules shall apply to the posts specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto annexed.
- 3. Number of Posts, The number of the said posts, their classification and the classification and scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in scale of Pay. Columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule aforesaid.
- 4. Method of Rectt. The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating age limit and to the said posts shall be as specified in column 5 to other qualification. 13 of the said Schedule.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct rectt. may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other Special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

5. Disqualification : No person :

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living,

(b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post. Provided that the Administrator may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 6. Training and Every Government servant shall undergo such training or pass such departmental examination as may be pres Examination cribed from time to time.
- 7. Power to relax. Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 8. Reservation other concessions
 and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled concessions
 Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
- 9. Repeal and All Rules pertaining to these posts, framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Govt. of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT (ii) dt. 21.
 1. 72 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

This order shall be in force with immediate effect and shall continue to be in force until further orders or till the enforcement of the Mizoram Excise Act, 1973 whichever is earlier.
