In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955) read with Government of India, Ministry of Agriculture (Department of Food)'s Order No. GSR 316 (E) dated 20. 6. 1972, the Lt. Governor of Mizoram is pleased to amend the "Mizoram Guest Control Order, 1972 to the effect that in Section 3 after sub-clause (iii), the following clause shall be added, namely :

"(3) The service of potatoes and any preparations thereof along with beverages and/or liquid refreshments at any party (irrespective of the number of persons participating) shall be exempted from the provisions of this Order"
