The terms of Office of members at Sl. 2 to 10 shall be for the period of One Year from the date of publication of this Notification and shall on the expiry of the said period continue to hold office until his successors is nominated and shall also be eligible for renomination.

The functions of the Vigilance Committee shall be :-

- (a) to advise the District Magistrate or any Officer authorised by him as to the efforts made, and action taken to ensure that the provisions of the Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976, and the rules made thereunder are properly implemented.

- (b) to provide for the economic and social rehabilitation of the freed bonded labourers.
- (c) to co-ordinate the functions of rural banks and co-operative societies with a view to canalising adequate credit to the freed bonded labourers.
- (d) to keep an eye on the number of offences of which cognizance ought to be taken under this Act;
- (e) to defend any suit instituted against a freed bonded labourers or a member of his family or any other person dependent on him for the recovery of the whole or part of an/ bonded debt or any other debt which is claimed by such person to be bonded debt.

The Deputy Commissioners of the respective District shall provide Secretariat Assistance to the Village Committee who shall regulate its own procedure.
