### ORDER

No. MAP. 200/72-B/51, the 23rd Dec., '76. Whereas an order placing Shri H. Vanthuama, Jt. Director of Agriculture, Mizoram, Aizawl under suspension was made by the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram on 30.8.1976 issued vide Govt. Memo No. MAP. 65/73/183 dated 30.8.1976;

And whereas the Disciplinary authority is satisfied with the findings of the Enquiring Officer that the Officer has violated the provisions of Rule 3 (1) of the Central Civil Service (Conduct) Rules, 1964;

Now, therefore, the Lt. ISSUED BY HEADS OF DEPARTMENT AND HIGH COURT

#### DECLARATION

No. LRR. 19/(A)/73-76/82, the 15th December, 1976. Whereas it appears to the Government of Mizoram that land required to be taken by the Government at the expense of the Deputy Commissioner Aizawl District for a public purpose viz. location of S.D.O. (Civil) Office Complex which is situated at Champhai. In the Aizawl District of Mizoram : it is hereby declared that, for the above purpose, land belonging to Shri Paul Zakhuma of Shillong measuring more or less 1,87,200 sqft of standard measurement bounded on the:—

Eastern Side of pillar.	No. 2—3	—	330	ft/metres.
Southern „ „ „	No. 3=4	—	350	ft/metres.
Western „ „ „	No. 6—1	—	200	ft.
Western „ „ „	No. 4—5	—	160	ft/metres.

Is required within the aforesaid district of Mizoram. The declaration is made under the prvision of section 6 of Act 1 of 1894 to all whom it may concern.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Collector, Aizawl Aizawl District.

Nothing in this declaration will be considered to apply to land which is resumable for the said purpose under the terms of the lease and which the Government elect to resume instead of acquiring under the Act.
