is proposed at Shillong for the Eastern Region in
India.
- (b) If so, the States going to join in the proposed
University.
- (c) Whether Government of Mizoram will take part in
the Management of this Hill University.

PU VAIVSAGA:
MINISTER.

Mr. Speaker Sir, Yes. So far
Government of Mizoram have not
received any official information
about it. In the absence of any official information
either from Govt. of India or from the participating
States, this Govt. have not yet been able to formulate
any policy regarding this issue. I also urged Mizo Members
of Parliament to use their influence for giving the name
"Indira Hills University" to this new University and for
inclusion of Mizoram (Union Territory) in the Council.
