Personnels are given equal amount of Special Pay ?

PU CH. CHHUNGA, Chief Minister: Mr. ^{RY} Speaker Sir,

(a) No.

(b) Under the Government of Assam the
AE ACS/IAS Officers who are posted as Under Secretaries are
given special pay of Rs. 200/- p.m. Such provisions have
been extended to the Government of Mizoram by the Government
of India vide their letter F. No. 3/16/72-MZ dt. 9.5.72
and allowed us ~~to practice~~ to follow Assam Government
practice in regard to special pay. As such this Government
has given special pay to ACS Officers when they are posted
as Under Secretaries under the Government. Other Under
Secretaries are not entitled such special pay on the ground
mentioned above. This Government moved the Government of
India, a number of times between September, 1973 and April,
1974 and also Chief Minister has written D.O. letter to the
Home Minister to sanction such Special Pay for Under Sec-
retaries who are other than ACS, but the Government of
India do not agree with our proposal. However, Shri S.S.
Dutta, Under Secretary, Finance Department who belongs to
Assam Accounts Service has been granted Special Pay of
Rs 150/-p.m. by the Government of India.
