1. QUESTIONS entered in separate list to be asked and answers given.

PRIVATE MEMBERS' BUSINESS

2. Pu L. Piandenga to move the following resolution :-

"This Assembly decries the incident of the killings of Mizos in Silchar in June, 1979 and conveys its sympathies to the bereaved families."

3. Pu C. Vulluaia to move the following resolution :-

"This Assembly recommends that the Government of Mizoram should make a provision for the giving of grants to students, bonafide residents of Mizoram, for pursuing higher studies, like research for Ph.D. etc., in any institution of higher education in the country, as is being given by the various other states."

4. Pu B. Lalchungnunga to move the following resolution :-

"This Assembly is of the opinion that suspension bridge be constructed on the river Mat in between Mualthuan (S) and Thualthu in Lunglei District."

5. pu Ellis Saidenga to move the following resolution :-

"This Assembly resolves that Large Scale Agriculture project be undertaken by the Government of Mizoram in Chamdur Valley in Chnintuipui District."

6. pu H. Rammawi to move the following resolution :-

"This Assembly is of the opinion that construction of Mizoram House be taken up in Shillong".

7. pu J. Thankunga X to move the following resolution :-
pu Bualhranga X

"Whereas under Article 46 of the Constitution of India, the State shall promote with special care, among other matters, the economic interests of the weaker sections of the people and in particular of the Scheduled Tribes;

And, whereas, the Government of Assam had been allowing certain concession in regard to the settlement of contracts, permits, fisheries, ferries, forest mahals, tolls supply of all materials and articles to Government etc., to safeguard the economic interests of the Scheduled Tribes;

And, whereas, the Government of Mizoram has in their order "o. HG. 61/73/12 dated 5th Dec. 1973 continued such concessions with certain modifications;

And, whereas, the said order is not very in certain respects;

Now, therefore, this House resolves that,

- (1) In respects of auctions or tenders which are settled at the lowest bid the auction or tender may be settled on a Scheduled tribe 12 percent above the lowest bid; and
- (2) In the case of auctions or tenders settled on the highest bid the auction or tender may be settled on Scheduled tribe at 12 percent below the highest bid.
- (3) Paragraph 3 of the said order relating to persons registered outside may be omitted".

8. pu Joe Ngurdawla to move the resolution :-

"This Assembly is of the opinion that Village Councils be constituted in the existing Thlawhbawks for the purpose of administering the same."
