LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY ON 11TH MARCH, 1987.

P R E S E N T

PU J. THANGHUAMA Speaker at the Chair, 9 Ministers and 27 Members were present.

B U S I N E S S

1. Shri Hiteswar Saikia, Governor of Mizoram to address the House.

S P E A K E R : Let copies of the Speech be distributed to member Sir ?.

S P E A K E R : It is considered unnecessary.

PU HIPHEI : Why recess has been included in the list of Business. if it is unnecessary. It is our practise to leave the house for ten minutes after Governor's Address.

S P E A K E R : Today we shall proceed unlike we did before. After distribution of the copies a Motion of Thanks will be moved. previously also, immediately after the Governor's Address, a copy was laid on the Table of the House, and after that copies were distributed to members.

PU HIPHEI : Mr. Speaker Sir, the best thing is to follow the List of Business, where it is listed that there will be 10 Min, to recess.

S P E A K E R : If you like, you may go out. Now we shall call Pu R. Lalawia to move the motion of thanks.

PU LIANSUAMA : Mr Speaker Sir, it would be unfair if you violate the Rules from the very beginning. Let Pu Lalawia move the motion after ten minutes recess.

PU R. LALAWIA : Mr Speaker Sir, as per the provision of sub-Rule (3) of Rules 12 of the rules of procedure & conduct of business Assembly, the Governor has now addressed the House. I now move the motion of thanks on the speech of the Governor.

The speech of the Governor mainly envisages the proposal to be taken this Government. And the value of the atmosphere of peace which has been restored. Therefore, this House is much indebted to the Governor for his speech hence the motion.

PU H. RAMMAWI : Mr Speaker Sir, while we are expecting you to conduct the House as per Rules you violate 12 of the rules of procedure & conduct of business in Mizoram Legislative Assembly.

S P E A K E R : No need to say such thing now. All of us have copies of list of Business in which it is clearly written that after the Governor's address, Pu R. Lalawia will move motion of thanks. We shall follow the list of Business,

PU VANLALNGHAKA : Mr Speaker Sir, in the list of Business, there is a ten minutes recess. Why don't we have the recess?

PU HIPHEI : Mr Speaker Sir, I am very happy to hear you announce that you would conduct the House as per Rules. But why this item no. 7 by passed? (Speaker : If we have ten minutes recess it is impossible to Assembly again in time) if so, why didn't you obtain the consent of the House.

S P E A K E R : Anyone to Speak ?

PU LIANSUAMA : Mr Speaker Sir, your contention that it is difficult to ~~Assemble~~ heresaga- in in time after a ten minutes recess it is quite true. Will you give us a chance to study the Address and start discussion tomorrow ?

S P E A K E R : We shall not have discussion today. The Business for today is just moving the motion. The Governor has addressed the House and Pu R.Lalawia has move a motion of thanks which is seconded by Pu H.Rammawi. Is there anyone who likes to speak okey, the BAC was constituted yesterday which will function under the chairmanship of Speaker. Pu Saingura Sailo; Minister i/c P.A. is ex-officio member, Pu R. Lalawia Pu K.Lienchia and Pu Lal Thanhawla are appointed members. But Pu Lal Thanhawla decline the appointment and in his place Pu Vanlalngena is appointed as suggested. Pu P.Lalramliana is also appointed member of the BAC, which has six members. After this sitting the committee will meet in the office of Speaker. The Business for today is finished.
