8. Some of the provisions of the Mizoram Peace Accord have already been implemented. My Government will take suitable steps to implement the provisions not yet implemented, in consultation with the Central Government. I am sure your collective endeavour and wisdom will ensure clean and efficient administration for the State which is crucial for orderly and quick socio-economic development of Mizoram. I earnestly appeal to all to work together with unity and goodwill, in order to maintain and strengthen Peace, Harmony and Progress, giving benefits to all sections of people in the State. I am confident that Mizoram will soon be the beacon-light and torchbearer in the country. My hearty felicitations and best wishes to you and the people of Mizoram. May your deliberations be fruitful and successful. Thank you.
