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FU E.LALTHLENGLAFA : Mr Speaker, sir, at the Session, we are alweys given positive answers. But such assurances often fail to matcrialise. kegercing the proposed reservoir at fibawk, a year has passed anc nothing is cone for its completion. As acute shortage of water is geced by my constituency, is the ministry just going to sit icle ? I request the Ninistry to take up more effective steps. At the same time. I honestly request the Hon'ble Ninister $i / c$ to fulfil his assurarces so that the problems of water will be solved to a.great extent.

PU H. TiANGKIVAA : Mr Speaker, sir, I learnt that at Luangmual, water is distributed at a gap of 3 to 5 cays, where full authority is in the honds of the driver. Is the Ninistry anare of such matter ? If so, will verification be uncertaken by the ministry ?

PU F.LALMKIMA : Mr Speaker, sir, the water conMINISTER nection taken from limuifang is estimeted for 7 Villages, such as Sumsuih, sateek, Thick, Nau-
buang, Lungsai, Phulpui and Aibowk. Since we learnt that the supply is insufficient for the said Villages particularly Fhulpui and Aibaw: drilling system is set up for the latter Villages, specially at Ehulpui, 3 drilding centres had been set up and already surveycd. Beside, a well haci been set up in the Villeges of ${ }^{4} \in l r i a t$ and Damdiai, while no step is yet taken up for Hualngo anc Kelsih as they fall uncer fizewl Fhase II. Apart from thet, rein water harvest scheme is underway in the Village of Lungleng. Regercing the foint raised by the Hon'ble Niember from Vanva will be verifiec. by the Government.

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What is the progress cf Tuinial Hycel Praject?


#### Abstract

FU C.L.RUALA : Mr Speaker, sir, as far as the MINISTER Tuirial Hycel froject is concerned, we expect to obtain the Environment clearance by the month of Aril. Ls we all know, the eroject Report was gi.ven by the Civ in 1991. The CEA granted Economic clearance in 1992 and the Forest clearance was obtained with much ifficulty in 1994. So, Environmental clearance is the last hurdle, and after going through all the formalities, we hope to obtain it by the month of April. Presently, the presence of wild life, such as clouetd Leopardis bothering the environmental experts:


PU ZCRAMTIANGA : Mr speaker, sir, I would like to know whether there is a single clouded Leopard?

FU C.L.RUALA
: Mr Speaker, sir, the experts are nct certain of the numbers, but they. firmly believe that the saic wild life exists only in the N.e.India, and they fear for its extinction. Its existence is proved by the experts. According to the report cf an expert fr John Singh, establishment of the said Project will not disturb the clouded Leopard of Nizoram and cther North Eastern regions.

EU ZCRANITHANGF : Mr speaker, sir, the supplementary question I would like to radse is how meny persons had been killed due tc shortége of power and electricity ? So, a single clouced Lecpard should not deley or hamper the progress of the saic frcject.

PU LALHMINGTHANGA : Mr Speaker; sir, today words cannot express the urgent necessity of reguler power supply. So, the presence of wild-life
in the saidare should not be a big issue in this matter.

This is merely a lame excuse, and which is a great humiliation for the $\in$ ntire people of Mizoram. Why so the Ministry fails to reelise the truth onc wiy do they continue to offer baseless justificetions, till dete? ks the neec for proper supply of Power \& Electricity is immensely high, can the Ministry provide information on the exoct situetion of the project, to the centre ? If not, we readily volunteer curselves to undertake the task.

SFEAKER : This is the guesticn nour, sc instead of making statement. you should reise the exact questions.


PU Fi.Thing $\quad$ : Mr Speaker, sir, supplementary question. What is the $l \in n g t h$ of the area between the Dam and the main road ? Whether road has been constructed or not?

PU LALRINCHFizNA : Mr Speaker, sir, if a barrier is to be constructed at Tuirial, in which part will the barrier be set up? What is the exact area tc be immersed and is the surrounding arees strictly preserve in order to avoid huge amount of compensetions?

PU B.LILTHLENGLIZNA : Mir Speaker, sir, is the entire pecple of Mizcram far more valuaile than the wild-life ? If so, can the boscless excuses be remeved by our leacers? will the central leacers continue tc have the same imeression on us ? fis we claimed tc be in the good bock of the centre, can such acivantage be availed now?

FU C.L.kUALfo : Nr speaker, sir, undoúbtedly, MILISTER the pecple of Mizoram are highly valuoble than the wild-life. Further, I would like to remind cur
Hon'ble Members thet we did convince the expert team, and they totally supported my opinion that a single wild-life should not cost the interest and benefits.of cur pecple. kis stated earlier, tc cbtain Environmental anc Forest clearances is not an easy task which cennot be done within e short span of time. Fpart from this. Techno-econemic clearence is olready acquired for the Tuivai 210 M , where Forest and Environment clearance are ancther recuirements.

Regarding compensation, only few
are in possession of $V / C$ pess and negotiation is underway now. Lastly, as long as we get all the clearance the froject will be completed long before 2010.

PU LALHMINGTHANGA : Mr Speaker, sir, the TEchno-economic clearance for Bairabi Dhaleswari project had been granted by the Central Electricity Authority on 10.10 .188 , a copy of which is in the hands of the Hon'ble Minister.in-chafge. The number is NH/ED/TP/35: 041/ 252, and the communication was given on 9 th January ' 89 . In such cases, why no further step was taken up for this project there appears tc be a political motivation in this regard. The fact is that in the history of CEA, nc clearance is granted if there is a deficiency in the investigeticn surprisingly, the Hon'ble House Leader claimed that since investigation of the said project was undertaken during the period of insurgency, the same has to be started all cver egoin. This is quite doubtful and it is herd to understand why the previous Froject is completely neglected so far?

PU C.L.RUALA
: Mr Speaker, sir. the said Bairabi Project was completed between the years 1982-!84. The reccraclearly shows that only $60 \%$ clearance was given for the froject.

FU FemALSAWMA : Mr Speaker, sir, my resolution is -

tc. meet cur needs in power and as
fower supply is nct sufficient, let a diesel Generator be putchased tc relieve the immediate needs of power supply for Mizoram'and I beg to move the resclution.

SPEKKER: You are allcwed tó move.

EU F.MALSAWMA : $\therefore$ Thank you, Mr speaker, sir, We all know how much cur state needs po-
wer supply. In every wolks of cur lives, everything is planned and designed as if we heve sufficient power supply. Due tc the shcrtage of power supply, we arc facing many problems. Even cne of the Hen'ble Nember esked that can we start construction work of Hycel Project after 15 years. is that is the case it is not known when we shall be sufficient in power. Sc, it is necessary tc secrch an immediate relicve. .
in $\AA$ izawl there is no power supply for cur neighbouring states at the time of examination of sthdents and we klame whoever forms the Ministry. I heard that some tecchers distribute cancle to their stucents. Many parents with Vcluntary Crganisation and Churches crganised functicns to encourage cur : youths to dig out their telents but that toc failec becouse of no power supply. Even cther important functions are disrupted by the failure of power supply which is beyond cur control. It the same time, average bililing was intrcauced according to which we have to pay at a very high rate. we reported the matter to the Hon'ble Ninister in-charge and it was reconsidered, sc point to point billing system was introcuced and yet the bill is still high considering how bad we got power supply. sometimes, there is fluctuation in power supply which damage our TV and cther electrical systems.

Cur minimum requirement of power supply is 56 M , while we have only 40.5 MW both from cutside Mizcram and generated by diesel and Micro Hycel project. our requirement is increasing every year. puring dry seascn, 22 MW which we get from our neighbcuring States decrease. Sc, it is very clear for cur need to have diesel generator for cur immediate relief. There may be cbjections from fir pollution Centrol and other Departments, but we can send Jcint farliamentary Delegation to iclhi to convey cur neecis, and I am sure we will be given special consiceraticn. I heard that the present Ministry is intending to purchase diesel generator and I would like to suggest to purchase generatcr which can generate at least $15 \mathbb{N W}$ which is cur minimum reguirement for fizawl Town and the nearby Villages. If we do nct purchase this, I feel cur cevelcpmentel progrommes specially in Industry secter will be hampered. So, as it pleys an impertnat role for the development cf cur state, Nir speaker, sir, I propose to buy Diesel Generator for immeciote relief and beg this Hcuse to pass this resclution.

PU R.TLANGHMINGTHANGA : Mr Speoker, sir, as we all kncw 'cur problem, it is not necessery to say much. While there was Diesel Genratcr et PCwer House, Ri-
zawl, we used tc have power supply regulerly but since we take power from our neighbcuring stetes, all lines at ecwer Hcuse were cut and from that onworcs we, the public es a whole seldom get power supply only VIfs used tc get power supply genereted by diesel Engine. From this alcne, we can see how valueble wes te gentrate pewer by Diesel Generetor. If that is the cnly generater w, $e$ have; it is high time to hove more Diesel Generators while there is proposal for hydro power of cur own I feel we deserve special consideration even in the level of Centrel Government in this regard. Being representative of the people, it is cur responsibility to consider the problem faced by our people, it is not enough that our Governcr, Ministers, some MUSis and some VIPs are getting power supply generated by our only diesel generator, so, keeping aside our party feelings I would like to request this House tc pass this resolution.

## PU SAIKAPTHIANGA MINISTER

: Thank you Mr. Deputy Speaker Sir, the resolution moved by the Hon'ble member Pu F. Nalsawma is clear enough. We all know the problem we are facing in regard to power supply. Mizoram is facing two big problems which are beyond our control, that is shortage of power supply and drug abuse.

For the development of Industries, Fgriculturel sector and even for all walks of cur lives power play an important role. We lag behind in varicus development because of insurgency. And I used to think the way we take up Bairabi Hydel Project from the beginning is not in a proper way that even Central Government dmes not give interest in it.

The Hon'ble member pu Tlanga
said Ministers and some Mifs and VIPs are regularly having power supply but that is nct the case, we are all the same, cur problem is all the same. Ins that is the case under the guidance of the Chief Minister and Power Minister, steps are being taken tc increase cur power supply. In agreement is * gcing to be passed tc use power generatcr through PFC. Therefore, it may not $L e$ necessary tc pass to purchase Diesel Generator because as this House is the highest legislator in Mizoram, we have to be very coreful even in our resolution.

It is not that I de not feel necessary that the resclution is saying but that as the matter is under corsideration. So, I would like to suggest to wait for the steps, taken by cur lecders.

What I would like to point cut is the way we receive power supply. Even in cne right we get it suddenly and then it went off sudienly. There is no time to $r \in p a i r$ everi for the workers in between it comes and goes. I used to feel the workers are not sericus erough. So, this metter needs thorcugh investigetion. ot the seme time, we, the consumers have to be cereful not tc. use more than cur allccetion. I would like to recuest cur Electricity authority tc be more strict in this regard and have thorcugh check.

I alsc would like to point cut is, is there a proper way of billing. Generally speeking, we dc not complain if we get power supply regulerly. Even if we do not get power supply, the bill is more or less the same. From the speech of the Hon'ble linister, it can be answered that even if we cen heve Hycro, it will be only after 2 or 3 years. Remembering this, there is a propesel for which an agreement is nearly signed, hs thet is the case, it is rot necessary to pass this resclution, but let us urge'the Hon'ble power Minister to teke fast steps in this metter.

EU ZCRENTHAKG
: Mr Speaker, I have often suggest the purchese of Diesel Generators during demand discussion. Reelising cur needs for power, the Government tergetted on Hydel fower. But, till today not €ven a single Hycel power thet could supply cur needs could not be sefn. Tcday's Resclution has also been moved.to strengthen the Government. There are two ways to obtoin power energy. The first is through Hydel project, which requires about 10. years for its implementotion. The secono one is to purchese Diesel Generators, which is the most immediate means.

Our Resolution elsc opts for the
divert cf our budget for the purchese cf diesel Generetcrs. However, the Members from the ruling used to stote thet the Central Government ciscoureged the purchase cf Diesel Generators. Es this is the case, we co should epproech the Central thet Diesel Generators is still the most suitable for cur condition. hs we heve aften steted before, the state Government hes taken up several Hydel frojects of which some of them were completed. But, it is sc regretable that mest of the Hydel frcjects did nct come out successful. Therefcre, it is a waste c.f cur buaget. Lerge amount of our budget has been spent on the construction of Hycel ercject, but most of them heve failed. . For cur besis of celculotion, power gererator could be purchestc with en amount of Rs. $1 / 2$ crores incluöing jrstallation while even a Mini Hycel frcject costs abcut fis. 242 lakhs.

Eower Generatcr with a capacity of 30 MN can be purchased for Rs. 45 crores. If we can get power in the bosis of this celculetion, 15 NW of power could be consumed by bizawl Town anc the other 15 wW will be utiliż $\alpha$ fer rural arees. In this wey, we cen get better clarificetion within the whole of Mizcram. It is alsc suggestec that the amount sanction for the construction of Nini/Micro Hycel Froject be civerted for the purchese of Diesel Generatcr. If properly meintained Diesel Generetcrs could last for 10 tc 15 years, By that time ycel Frojects will be completed. This besis of celculetion is veryconvenient tc ergue the authority at Delhi. The opposition Nembers ore also ready tc gc tc Delhi to negctiete in this matter. Therefore, it is necessary and will be fruitful to adopt this resclution.

PU LIKNSUGMR MINISTER
: Mr Speaker, at the lest sitting cf the Planning Board. I raise one suggesticn. However, due tc the cifficulty in oltering the existing Plan, it was nct adopted. That suggestion was today seems to be relevant with the subject under discuss. Hence. I will point"it cut again.

For the consiération of the auEhority, as pcinted cut by Pu Tlanghmingthanga, I advocated for the installation cf privote Diesel Generatcr. In the present condition, the Government is taking up a number of Diesel Generatcrs in wich the establishment cost is cuite high. In this connection, as already preactised by other states and Cities, the Gevernment may better enecurage the installaticn of private biesel Generatcr. If this can be cone, the Government will be frec cfesteblishment cost ond will seve lerge amcunt of money besides the increase in power Oneraticn capacity. Power will be procuredin a mass and will be stocked in the Transformer et Zemabawk. Sc that we could get. better electric supply.

We should also nct disregardmicre Hydel Froject in cur present situation. We should rether enccurage for the rafic completion of Hydel frcjects. Befcre, the completion of Micro Hydel Frojects enccuragement should Le given to private Diesel Generatcr.

If it is convenient, the existing Diesel Generatcr set at hizewl be transfer to zemabawk fower station, sc that better electrification cculd be provided. Even if the existing rate cf $90 \mathrm{p} \cdot \mathrm{per}$ unit is increesed to Rs. 2/- it will be appreciated by the public if regular power is supplied.

: We shall call upen $P u$ Fublremsiema after thet the Ninister in-cherge may toke the stand.
: Nr speaker, it seems that the Minister in-cherge has nc concentration on cur subject. fos power is very importont for us, we all support higher capecity of power by the use cf diesel generator, If pcssible. However, the Central Gcvernment dces not favcur Diesel Generotcr. But, the cese of Mizoram is specially considered and Diesel Generator is permitted reelising cur urgent needs for power. Therefcre, we should take advantage of this by enccuraging Diesel Generetcrs.

I would alsc like tc suggest that insteed of concentrating only ct Hydrc Electric pcwer, Thermal fower station may alsc be taken up. It has alsc been said that cne cf the main reascns for the self sufficiency cf power in West Bengal is. Thermal fower stetion. The Gevernment cf Mizorom should also concentrate on the installation cf Thermal Pcwer Steticn, so that we may be able to be more sufficient in fower supply. Lastly, I also support the suggestion of privatisation raised by the Minister of Rural development.

: Nir speaker, as we have already heard
besiōes the pocr concition cf cur
Power Generation, cur recuirement in
Previcusly, the power recuirement in
power is highly increaseci. Fizewl Town was 16 Niws. But, since the month of September the $r e q u i r e m e n t ~ h a s ~ g o n e ~ u p ~ t o ~ 18 ~ i W s . ~ i s ~ t h i s ~ i s ~ t h e ~ c e s e, ~ t h e ~ G e-~-~$ vernment had organised a raid on our power consumption on hizawl Town alcne, which checked cown power consumption by about 2 NW. In this way, the Gcvernment hies taken up measures in orcer to setiates the pcwer requirements of the whole of Mizcram.

The Niember from Kizawl North - II had menticned the case of average billing cf power. This has been introduced just for a while to check the misuse of power. Tc meet cur requirement we also had a negotiation with the Central Government. $\langle s$ a result of the efforts mede by our Chief Minister, ancther $41 / 2$ Mws of power hes been received from the Central. Ancther 5 MN s is expected to be received from the Kothalguri preject which is to be commissicned today. The total capacity of power drawn from the Central beccmes $171 / 2 \mathrm{Mis}$. tcgether, with all the power obtadned from cur vini Hydel and Diesel Generators, we can have 42 vivs while cur actual requirements is about 54 MW . Therefore, we are, still very far from

However, the Central Government is never enccurage Diescl Generatcr as it is quite expensive. The average rate in viesel Generatcr is Rs. 3.50p per unit while only 90 p is charged per unit. $S c$. there is no profit for the Gcvernment. As a result $6 f$ the hard pressure by cur Chief Minister; the Central Government has given its approval for the purchese of Diesel Generatcrs for the stete of Mizofam. Tender hes also been flcatec for the supply of diesel Generetcr with a capecity of 5 MW . Being the lowest bidder, Kirlcskar*Company has $E \in \in n$ selected. And a contract i.greement will be signed shortly.

If pecple could be given power upto the maximum then it would have been the best Department, but as this is not the case, we suffer much problem cn it. Bleming one ancther is a man's work so it is ncthing if there is no power tc supply.


Big Hydel Prcject are blessings but they: are delayed by the Central Gcvt. for a long period. We hove sven asked the prime Minister to interfere in cur Hydel froject but ncthing has come out sc far. The careteker cf our Prcject have been taken at the sites by Helicopter,etc. so all ve can Co is wait for it as this cur disagvantage. Those who are a problem for us happen to be the mein futhority of India but now the Chairmen seems to be trying to take crderswithout the consent of the Board.

We have made coly Mini-Hycel
Project and nct big ones. The Diesel Generation is nct gecd encugh for our stote due to its meinteinence cost. cur Engineers have also tried hord on it but the machines are a big problem for us.

Jotikan and Cromwell have been the companies which have failed us but now we have thought cf foreign collobcrations as their works and output will be better in the long run even if the price may be higher. Improvements are shown but we have failed due to the equiptments. So we have to look for Companies that will not fail us. NonConventicnal Scurces Energy will pay $15 \%$ while $15 \%$ will be paid by us. The $15 \%$ we have cannot be used in anjway besides the Mini Hydel Project.

The tender for 5 Mowt has been answered by kirloskar agent and as the price is the lowest with the quotation and tender term condition being fulfilled, I believe that the contract has been awarded tc them. The two insulators will give out 2.5 k wht in one year and the cther things needed will be supplied.

As we don't have the much needed requirments straight away we will have to settle for the iilesil Generatcr granted to us. We now can make the $15 / 20$ mega watt which may be desired by cur power Minister according tc
cur cash amount. Due to cur problems, Shri Rajiv Gandhi had allcwed us to build 2.5 Nega watt in 1986. Cur state has been granted even though we have not been allowed by others due to cur great difficulty.

Pu Lalliana Mualchin has advised cur Power Vinister on various kinds of Companies. We had also asked the help of Ronald Sawma, U.S 8 project but we have not come cut with any success. Cur tender form has also been filled by Companies from England but cur Tender Reguirement has nct $b \in \in$ f fulfilled:

We have also esked the power Finance Corporation to divert the 32 crores we hod borrowed like the Central Power Minister had advised us. Cur hopes are high as there is transmittion for every different Corporation. Sc 5 mega watts must be made eyen if the price may be over 30 crores.

Now we can be bolder as we know the minds of this House. As it is the step we had taken before we ask you not to pass this Resolution as it will mean that you don't believe our move. We will try our best in every way.

SPEAKER DCes it meen that we will try to buy another 5 Mega watt if the House agree on it ?

## PU LAL THANHAWLA CHIEF MINISTER

: Pu speaker, it is not to ask if: the House agrees on it as we. already know the mind of this August House and this is something which is an absolute necessity. Our main problem is the money which is hard to get and we don't have yet. As the opposition Nembers have even made a Resolution on it we shall be bolder in our steps. - Thank you Mr peaker, as I had submitted it befcre, it read *Since Nagalend has its cwn University, NEHU Campus at Kchima
ke shifted at fizawl, Nizoram*, but as the assets and lideility was already transfered I was told by the Heputy Registrar and Fro-Vice Chancellor that it was inappropriote. Asking for its amendment $I$ then changed the Resclution.

NEHU was established in 1973
and was called Indira Ganchi Hill University, lut later it was changed to North Eastern Hill University. In the NEHU Act, 1973 No. 6 it says "The Jurisdiction cf the Uriversity shell extent to the State cf leghelaya and Nagaland, enc the U.T. cf Arunachal Fradesh ond Mizcram ", but arunachal Predesh and Nagaland (6.9.1994) had their cwn University and *ere excluded. These two states cculd nct tronsfer all thein assets and liabilities to their cwn state university. with UGC's permission, Kchima and Meziphemeopticned for NEMU in their service.

In Kchima, they could study M.Sc, Geclogy and Mining wing, M.Ccm, Mif linguistic, No Fistory, ircheolcgy, History, English, Ecucation and Fh. D. is we have $N$ is English and tducation, we don't neec to open a new wing. NEHC is now shared by Mizcrem and Meghalaye as the cther two have their own Universities. If we compere the - Shillcng Campus with $f i z a w l$ Campus, they heve a much better supply of everything as shillong is the Heecquarter.

The Khasi have $b \in \in$ trying their best to enlarge the shillong campus. If we pass it here in the assembly, cur children and their children will te able to st-udy $N \bar{h}$ in these five cr six Departments here in bizavl。It will alsc be an income generating scurce for the state not to speak cf employment facilities for many.

The schcol cf Fgriculturel Science and Rural Develcpment under NEHU ot Mezipheme in Nagaland is also very well euipted and thriving now. :The faculty cf 5 keaders, 12 Lecturers and cre peon heve opted for neru scrvicea as given the right tc cption.

While cll cur ncighbcuring stetes have set up their Ccllegcs under Central University, Mizcram hes nct $y \in t$ sterted funcfioning of Vety Ccllege till dote.

The Rogional Modical Colloge under NPC is in Iminhal, Contral Univorsity of Agriculture is also in Imhal. Itanagar has also College of Forostry which is also under NeC. Only Mizo‘ram lacks those facilitios for Technical and Medical Education.

Therefore, we should toke this chance. Tripura also has an Institution for study of Diploma in Phermacy, whore a good numbur of Mize youngetors are studying. It is hightime to ur e the Contrai nal U.e.C., to grant us to oxen tho said Dopertmenes at the deve comus in Aizewl。

Wo speak of heving a Concral University, but so far we cannct say when this is goint to bocome a reality. It has not been finalised in parliamont. However, if wo have a Campus in Mizoram under UCC it mill bocome an asset and liability when we do have a University. It will be as an infrastructure for the University. I, therefore, hopefully request this House to plasu fass this Besolution that $I$ heve introuced in the Housc.

Mr speaker, sir, todey our Rosolution is of utmost imprtance and in this connection, whet $I$ would like to oxpress is that in the jrevious term, a Resolution concerning the establishmont of a University in Mizoram wes moven by mea as the case mroccoded and the same was discussed in the Fouse, a decision was mado to set up a Contral University hore for which a project Report was duoly prepared and submitted br the educationel Consultent, Delhi. Tivo or, three years neve pessed but nothing is Jone by the centre till cate nor is there any eiscussion of this topic in the parlimment. This is a great disaiointmont for us and it is the duty of the state Government to iumsuc this mattor more offectively.

Moreover, we have buen afililated to mbu fur a long period of timo, yot, with the dacoption of P.U.College and iostel, there is no formanent structure or Guvalumont in mizoram. Above all, in the year 1992 , the amount of fund allotted for development of Mizorem's Cemi us by iNEFU is less than $5 \%$ of their budget. Az Nexu comrises of Mizoram, Nagaland and Me, halaya, allotment of less than $5 \%$ is too moagre, which is extremely frustrating for us. Hunco, a serious and deep consideration is needed for further progress of our state. At the same time, I strongly recommond the wessing of this Rasolution. As far as the establishment of University is concerned, immediate nocotiation with hicher authority is necessary, and in particular, it is the responsibility of the Hon'ble Chief Minister to. pursue this task more offec-
