tant persons even while there is acute shortage of sugar for the public. What will be the total quantity of sugar reserved for this purpose in a year?.

PU R.THANGIITNA: Mr.Speaker, there may be different interpreMINISTER. tations on the worl"important persons" and our views may also be different. However. about 3 qtls or 4 qtls have becn made available every woek according to the importance of the demand. This could be purm chased by use of special permit from C.U.Seth. Also 25gims of sugar anc issued very week to cach individual person. The reserved stock of 3 qtls is not meant specially for officers. It is issued to persons according to the importance of their demand.

PU C.LALRUATA: Mr.Speaker, what is the monthly quota of sugar for Mizoram?.

PU R.THANGLIANA: Mr.Speaker, the monthly quota of sugar is MINISTER. about 1190 quintals." The quota for the preceadng month is distributed to the public in the next month and it rotates in this manner.

PU K.SANGCHHUM: Mr.Speaker, supplementary question: in the past, air-droppings were done in various Air Dropping centres; but it hes now been discontinued. Have tho government may proposal for its continuance?.

PU R.THANGLIANA: MINISTER.

Mr.Speaker, in the past, accounts on airdroppings had never been taken into govern. ment acceunt and no air-droppings were done in places whore jeeps can ply.

Air droppings of sugar, mustand oll,rice etc., mere done only in dastant Group Centres which have no jeepable roade. The system has now been changed by the government.
F.HRANGVELA: Mr.Speaker, supplementary questions the Hon'ble member has pointed out some minutes ago that dealers selling to special permit-holders are made to sell. sugar as the commodity is after, found in acute shortage for the publir : In Aizawl town sugar is purchased on special permit system. The special dealers are M/S Chhotalal Beth and M/S N.c.Bhattacherjee. But it is tearnt that sugar is out of stock then people go to purchase it from these two special dealers. Does this mean that the dealers kept sugar for their private stock or the government issued special permit without considering the exact quantity of sugar kept in stock by these two special dealers?.

PU R.THANGIIANA: Mr.Bpeaker, this was not done according to the sweet.will of the dealers. The exact quantity of sugar which can be purchased with special
permit is fifed every week and no person is allowed to purchase without spectal permit. Let us suppose that 5 gty $O$ fisugar is issued to the dealers for a particular week. If all the persons having special permits could not get sugar from the dealeris, it means the stock bad been exhausted! . The prosent system is intwo duced in order to prevent smuggling (boarding?) by the dealers.

present the Budget.

Mr. Speakcr Sir,
I rise to present the
Revised Estimate for 1972-73 and the Budget istimate for 197374 to the House.

The Hon'ble mearers are aware, that presentation of tie Budget of Mizoran as an Unicil Territory to the Legislative Assembly requires prior approval oí the Central Goverment. We have tried to nake our Judgut as an intrument and channel for realisation of our economic and social objectives. I an pleased to wention that the Central Government continuo to extend thear syapathy and co-operation $i o$ us in this respect. As asainst the sross provision for the smenditure during 197272 of Rs. 16.8 Grores, the gross exponditure I shall present for the 1973-74 budeet is Rs. 23.6 Crores. In addition to this, thirough the conscious effort yade by our Chief Minister, the Planning Comuission has äreed to jive us an adiditional jrant of Rs. One Crore, which shall be included in the Revised Estinate and bringing thus the total to Rs. 24. 6 Crores for 1973-74.

Hardly five months have passod since I had the privilege to present the Dudzct for $1972-73$ to this Aufust body. The flon'ile members are aware that it had taken sometime to organise the Developineni, Departwints on this Governnent, and to put tho. into shape, and it vas oniy about three ionths ago that the staf'f in streneth were placed in poeition in various Departnonts and the Secretariat. As a resill, the delay that had occured in execution of sone schemas was inevitable. In spite of these difficulties and the very lisited tion at our disposal, I an glad to :ontion that the Devoloment Departionts express their ability to utilise almost the entire fund ut their disposal. It is encouragine to know that the centrol Govorment, in spite of thoir finanolal dificicuities irwient about by the last year drouglt and othor faotors, have irates tlectreadiness to spare additional fund for us wion demaded in our supplenentary budget, provided ve can oriy spend tho pruscre allotiment woll and in tise. .
In ay Budict inpectr or Inst year, I nentioned the difficult cireurtanees in which wo werc jaced and how we were fasua with tho task of startine developinet works afresh after a $10 n$. jrur caused by disturbancos. It is sad to point out this tin. Also tiat there was al $\because$ alume of nonsoon last year due to a severe drourgit. This led to a jon horvest and an extensive loss of cropis iy the cultivators and we aro now feced with sexa scarcity and groot harhship this yeur also. This drought was nationwide ad the loss it caused to tho country was imense. I therofure, tifo this opyortunity to reaind the fouse of the
great anci alldeus uon
concerncd and allout efforts for achicving our targets.
To reet the imediate probien of scarcity condition the Goveriment have started stock-takine in rice and other esscntial comaditios through the state Trading schone at the Headquartors an! elsevhere.

The roadside contres have now wen well stocked and the others that used to be fed by air previously are beins supplied through hond load. This policy has to ve adopted for economic reasons ad to give caploynent, gencration to those who are in ned of such employment. Continued efiorts are being made to make sugar, Salt and Kcrosine Oil available to the people at a reasonable price. Let us not, howover, forest that these are of temporary mersuros and it should be our concerted effort to stop dependance on outside suipily of coodstuff and to achieve solfsuffiniency.

## Revised Estinate for 1972-73.

Revised Estimates for the poriod fron 3.5.72 to 31.3.73 are based on roquircment of fand as demandod by the sponding Departmerts. Measures taken in tine Revisod Estinate may be nentioned. As the Hon'ble Fherbers any bo aware, the Planning Comission made an allotnent of an auntional fund of Rs. 162 lakhs on top of the Dudect Provision of Ris. 275 lakiss in the Plan Schencs for 1972-73. A large sum was to be provided for reller measures to meot the extreme food scarcity condition last year in addition to measures takon under Employmut, Gereration Sehemes, Test Relief and Gratuitous Relief. The Governnent sanctioned about 50 lakhs as Agriculture Distress Loan, to be rep-aid in one yoar with $5 \%$ intorust by the Loanees. I an sorry to poit out that the rate of repayment is far below our expectation and particularly in the Aizawl District. This has resulted in the cutting down of the net fund available for other types of Loan during tho current juar. It is hoped th the Hanible Menbors of the House will help the Governient and do tileir best in inducing our people to honour the promises and the contracts iade by them to repay the Loan if and wher they are in a position to do so.

## Budget Esti:atos 1973-74d

Budet Estimates for a particulars year are made generally ir the months of Soptemer and october of the previous year. I , my rucall that onr adget for 72-73 was veted by this flouse ang in ihu last week of octiour, 1972. That was the time when we had no proper urjanisution for various Departnents. To inplement tio scheres and to utilise the fund fruitfully was the imnediate tasis of the rovernrent Departilents during Noverabor, 1972 and afterwaris. That peculiar situation coupled with staff re-organisation made it extromely difficult for the Governaent Dejamthents to rur are iudget Estiates for 73-74 and with due apology I riny atate that our Budzet Estimates under Non-Plan for 1973-74in the Plun schens for the periud were ade in a groat burry and takon to the goverment of lmia at a very late stajo. Bualize of the specinl understanding whown to us by the Government of india we have been aile to get the increased allotront ol fund for the Budget Estinates for 1973-74 as compared to the :urrent year. The Plan Schenes whon werc discussed by the Dovelopmant Dor armenta with the Flaminj Comission in the second weok of January, 1973 were considorod and the approval of the Piannine Comassion for an allotnont of ite. 5 crores was roceived by us only in the thire wow of last month. The allotiment of fund for tho ilan sundes of ib. 5 crores was considered indecuat: oy us and inwisotely ma Chiof jinister rushed to
