I have replied similar. question in the question hour, which have not yet satisfied them. ivo man is perfect committing some mistakes. I thought improper to tell how decision was made to take action etc. and punishment. Instead of saying in detail how action has been taken, I replied in short that action has been taken. Our forefathers said " Do not kick the dead animal". After Gavernanent has taken action on the wrong things done by false practicers, I replied action has been taken without dischosing the detail decision in this August House which may lower its dignity. The Headmaster of Hnahlan High Schorl was discharged and disalloved to serve in any High school, even the Deputy Commissioner and the Police Department were informed to do their part. Surction is not easily available for the matatenence of Dietrict council as it is given in the Com of grant-in-ain iron Cutral Govemment . On 25.5 .72 order to re-instate hir vas finvised. During his abscnee one officer was postod as his substitute hence tho question of two officers in ono and the same post arose. We hed to pay then bot! . .inring the period betweon 21.1.72 and 25.5.72. Pu Laidanzuala was ro-instate arterward but his taching method was not attrantive. W don't like issam Goverment to neglect decision of Mizora: Goverment, we therefore informod Assam Government to ro-employ hia.

Regarding school Establishment we thought we improved nuch nore then under hisam Government in Educational Department.

Viłbage Council affairs was mentioned, if wo sce our Rules, in Village Council elction only because one larty gets majority the Village Council cannot be reshufficd. Whether we are satisfied with the Rules or not is other thing, the position of the President, being electod, is stable. There is no provision in the Rulos to discherge him froil offico, if he doesn't submit resignation or by premature death. Even if the majorito don't like hin thare is no provision to remove hin. If his Party is weak and his colleagues also dislike him he should be wise enough to resign. In some Villages a lind of No-Confidence motion vas noved, which the Rule does not provide. After Union Territory Government 22 Village Councils held re-election in which Union or congress are elected. The Secretaries of both Revenue and L. A.D. are to arrange the suitability, nothing inproper would be involvea.

In "edical Departinent, fee for operation was said to De charged, which is wrong. It is paid only in Paying ward which we don't have henco patients don't pay fee for operation. ( Pu Lalsangzuala: If so, is operation free of charge ?) We charge no free. Something was mentioned regarding financial position. We cannot depend on As sam Government. Firn since we have U.T.Government, but we had no fira of our own yet, and have to purchaso fedicines from Local stores. We called quotation fron firms and spent much for modicines. Aven the C.E.I. is making investigation, where something wrong was found out, action was taken. If more is found it shall be charged. ( Pu Zalama : Ir. Speaker Sir, was the suspension done by C. 3.I. or the Department concerned) The Government suspended tioc alloged porson.

The task is no casy for the Ministar-in-charge, I an glad we 2ll pay attention to it. In fact, Supply \& Transport was inproper since long time ago, account vas not maintained and the expendituro on one Jeep, cocidd not be calculatod, prior to our finistry. We all know the problen and solving it is not easy, serious illness is slow tD cure. I shall reply Opposition Leader's question, as he is too anxious and can't sit properly. is he said difficulty is too deep rooted; the Motors layinf there unservicoable are due to nonavailability of Parts which are lost sonewhare. The serviceable are tenderly cared now, kecnine the exponditure account and the distance covered by aintaining Log Books, which means improvement is made than before is supply \& Transport is under one and the same Diroctorato we cannot mentioned separately, as hon ble rembers said, Supply is quite a problen and their criticis: $s$ are rights. Improvement is tried and the employees are around one thousand (1,000) in lizorarn, aloug with Borters, the biggest number under one Directoratic. The previous iethod is adorsted, and location of Portcers is being sought; previously thoy were detailed to escort Officers in thcir tour which is nd longer needed, but they cannot be sumply disnissed as they are helpless. Proposal to post then as IV Grade erployens is being considored. Even the 1.0 .5 pity thon, so alco the Contractors while we are shouting condenning corruption a wise fan ray conterrplate corruption, (Pu J.Thanghuana : Sr. Speakor Sir, we did not pass the Bucest to emloy Transport as Porters and donesticc servents. I ajn dircetly asking you whether it is a fact that sone officers employ them as donestic servants ?) Supply is a problem in the whole of India. I shall reply hon'ble fember's question, there are no Xransports on duty in the inisters' Houses ......
( Pu J.Thanghuan: The innisters are said to be employing then : ) Our Off'icers are entitled to omploy them as Eeon and Chowidars whi shall be regularised lator on, even Director koops such, but the numbers mentioned is wrong.

These shall be later on employed as Peon or Chowkidar etc. and may be their servants. Regularisation is meant to reduce Porters. Since 1959 the deficiency of Supply in Mizoram is chronice but we can hardly manage to survive, we nay blame Officers and some individuals, there is truth to sone extent. I an glad the Supply Department could do this for after such difficulties. Formerly, airdropping was the means of Supply which is costly, and lose is inevitable. Headiond Systern is meant for the people for earning their income. Loop-hole is on all sides, we lost in Headload too, sonething is wrong somewhere. Inspite of such difficulties we can hardly survive till today without loss of lives for which I praise the Supply Department.

One hon'ble Opposition Member said about the Block which he sold to be neither Arunachal pattern nor ill India pattern. We proposed to create 20 Blocks under $12 l$ India Pattern, but the Planning Commission suggested irunachal pattern under which 20 Blocks with few stafif and sanction will be nade, but we refused this. The Comission allowed creation of 20 Blocks under Ail India Pattern. In the mean while the existing Blocks are not closed but are all functioning, where A.Os. and even Overseers took Block Officer's charge. Though the 20 Blocks are under ill India Pattern, we have to find a way to manage ourselves as Central India is a bit poor this year. We shall do that later.

You mentioned the igriculture Department's emidyment in the wrong sense. As the Chief Whip said, we have no hope in igriculture, we have new hope of success in Dry Terrace Cultivation. You were invited with a hope that you nay pronag te it, but you interpreted as picnic which is regretful. We should encourage it. I thought you were busy in your works, but you interpreted as picnic. I want to say pronotion in figriculture though it concerns only few persons. You said, "You backdated sone while neglecting others", which is true to sone exterit. Those who were back-dated al ready hold the charge of their present occupation, those who were not back-dated are those who have not proviously taken charge. For instance, Dr. Zokhuna, hoving taken charge long ago was back-dated as best possible. Pu K.Laliann, D. i. O. after having taken charge J.ong ago was back-dated on D.P.C. basis (instead of the strength on his havins talson charge) So, also is the ciatter with Pu ‥T. Chhunge, Soil Conservation Officer.

In other Department too, like Civil Surgeon was back-dated from the date he took charge as well as the Principal, College (P.li.G.). The practice is used in Agriculture Department too. Those who have not taken charge cannot be back-dated.

Hoe distrivuted by agricultute Denartment was displuyed here by the Opposition Leader. I thourht it will that sonething was wrong the Director vas cilled and ordered to replace this before the Consultative Committee, I don't know how it is processcd now. The opposition Leader said only Rs. 1 lakhs was incurred during the period between 1st ay and Sth soptember, I an glad such could be incurred durin ${ }_{i}$ 5 months. I think be calculatod from the nnswer given. Forest Deparment have problen, duties are detailed in Forest Check Gate but $10 \%$ is difficult to make. But they cannot watch the whole night.

The Education Tinisetis said running of College Bus, Government don't permit us running Bus in the 'Strect, it should ban to Lunglei and other olaces. In othor bié Citios Government nover runs Town Bus, it is run in National High-Ways. In privato ius ban be run with Governinent subsidies rate, permit can be had at any time. If it does not run regularly like Town Buses Government con't opprove it.

The Opposition Leador said our Cement Quota at Cal cutta was black-iarkoted which I cannot digest. Our quota aliotnont for the poriod between January and varch was 500 etric tonnes, wut of wich 95.2 "etric tonnes was recsived. Dusing the period botwoon April and June 1,100 retric tonnes of allotrient recoived, and in the hands of the P.V.D., Fachhunga \& Sons shared 47.6 Etric tonnes. During the period betweon July and Sontanber 1,000 letric tonncs ( about 1,000 Bag $\$$ was received (out of 330 ietrie tonnej). For the period botwon October and December, 1500 fetric tomac was allotted to us, including the P.W.D. We expect 10 Whons of ox" Conent Allotment which is reant for public, the P.W.D. quota shall cone later. The Central Government orders every Firm to Supply such and such Fetric tonnes to iicoran, our delers here at hizawl happen to be tic Fixws' igerits. The Pir, sends ard the acknowledgenont ©opy is given to Sumpy Departilert. Our dealers left no aliotwent unliftod. I clon't know why our Cement allothent should be black-marketud at Celcutta, for which our Opio-

sition Leadcr is not satisficd. If the whole allotment is black-narketed it is other case. What the Firm released with information to us are no left unlifted. From the month of January onvards to June, due to drought electric power could not function, we have to know that the whole of India suffered for this. From July to Scptember, out of 1,000 Wtric tonnes alloted for us, 330 Metric tonnes arrived. 4,100 ittric tonnes is the total alloted for us for this year, inciucing some for P.W.D. Public works Department have separate allotment from Supply Secretary. What I said is for publie use, the unlifted is P.W.D. allotment.

The oucstion, 'Why we received half quota of R1ce Supply' is often put, I want ifermers to know the reason. The F.C.I. Godown was full of Boiled ri more than 8,000 Quintal $s$, but no other rice was ava 1 able, we refused Boiled rice but we could not help starving, so we Orderea by Telephone to send all available Bailed Rice. Yesterday about 1,000 quintals arrived Aizawl and Lunglei. Wo don't like boiled rice for lizoran. Rice is costly even at Mizawl. But there is no other way, fron next week Boiled rice may be supplied at Aizawl. Mizoram gets the best supply in Chini. In other States like Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Calcutta etc, adult gets 100 grams per week, while we get 200 Grans hexe. Even when we rake it half, it is equal to full quota of other places. If F.C.I. Godow have no Sugar we know other places from where to get.

Our Opposition Leader adviced us, that if it is insufficient we should derand nore, if it is sufficient he shall sce for himself.

Fr. Speaker sir, non-controlled sugar
is unfit for supply, To tell the truth, when non-controlled Sugar is released from Factory the price has to be high, when the price rise it results in stickes in other states also. The Traders are dis-interested. If we are to import noncontrollcd Sugar, we shall have to make it Rs. $5 /$ - per Kg . here. Government cannot afford such and avoid. ( pu zalawma: For what purposo the Chief Socretary keeps 10 portors, and the Director 8 Porters ?) "T. Speaker Sir, Director does not keep 8 Porters, heykeps 4 Porters as Office Peon and Chowkidar. The Deputy Conriissioner to keeps 2 porters likewise. (Pu J.Thanghuraa: Mr.Spenker Sir, allow me to read out1. Hagalrin; 2. Ali Husain; 3. Lalmawia; 4. Laipawnga; 5. Ali Kuran; 6. Lalthakina; 7. Deva Kuran; 8. Sangkhuma and many others. Whow we keep regularly).

This.is Eentrally Sponsored Schome, not throuth liomo Ministry, as the Industrial Dovelopmont separately sanction this, the Fund is insufficient and delay apoointment of tho Orficer, through interviow was hold. We still demand more fund for the purpose.
(Pu Zalawa: Is it truc thot though the pay scalc was fixed at, Rs. 750/- in tho Acivortisomone, it.was reducod to Rs. 350/- ?) Duv to shortage of Fund we could ofrer only Rs. 350/-, we cannot afiord Rs. 750/- pay scalc yet. Even if it be shameful. there is no heln if the Cmental Government have not provided or do we pay hirs from our Solary: Director of Industries is under Non-PJan which is to be croatcd. Tis applicant should have good experience is Industrial matter as the task is important, we cannot appoint an cxperienced person as there aro Industrin schonos and don't want to start it inperfectily. We request Contral Govemment to give hints by sending Depury Director or jt.Director, tiney suggestec names whosc confidential reports arc sought for, which is under process.

Industrial Loan, Grant-in-Aid ctc. arc siven to those whom the Boart consiclered to bo roliable for irplemontativo ${ }^{2}$ repayment of the hoan. Sewing Mechine was montioned which wi., givon artor tho Industry Dopartmont stif? rade vorification. The rominuer are given to those who are recomendod as nocly.

Iovomue Dejartmont was said to have no set-u ${ }^{j}$. Sines the Thion Torritory GJvernment, District Council's iovonue starf, wre re-organisoc and thore was no staff to work. Aifteco trat poriod orfanisation was made apointine officors which is not yot sufficiont. Wo rocuiroc? exporioncod Ofricse to suide Revenue Deprartment. Revenue De, retmont (re) Oreanisation is startad, we cxpect to bo able to as, oint Officorc. The Revenus Derartriont's Diructorate Office was soic to be unfriondy to the public, which may b. true. The stafil Meribers, from the lowest to hiehest try to cacorato with tho public, it my bo cluo to hoavy rusk of pubic they cannot the ruli croporation. The staff lembers try to holp anil cooperate the peoric. Even beiore one whole yone iass, around 1,7000 passes have to be macle for this

purpose we need more staff and better Office to accommodate the staff. Sanction for additional need has been received, I hope they shall be friendly and cooperation then.

In the Revonue Department, 'Selected C.As.' are said to be jostec, C. As. appointed as Fleld Supervisors served and have experienced in the work, the Board selected the fit ones, C.Is. are not still deprived of their rights, some C.As. are stili scrving as C.As.
( Pu Lalsangzuala: If so, how many C.Is. are included?) If some C.Is. are excluded it mist mean they lack exporience.

The Revenue Department is being de-Centralised as far as possible. Officers, Asst. Settlement orficer and other staff are given power within their capacitics, If much more is needed, it shall be done.

The Opposition Leader said Pu Thangliana was given site for stall by the Revenue Department but the Revenue Minister denied, hence there is confussion, either of then is wrong. Pu Zalawna in his question No. 36 asked "Whether there was proposal to cllose down public step between Jail Road and Bara Hazar Moin Road and give it for private Stall ?" Bazar Area Stalls arc to bc re-adjusted as some people occupy more space than the pass held. If empty space Is made out of ro-adjustment Pu Thangliana shall ge given hence the reply was 'No'. The empty space is other place. The form of question was "whether it is a fact that space........: as it is so we don't give the space, occupied by public step, to Pu Thangliana.

I might have given unsatisfactory reply to the question regardint Pu Thanglian's building Construction at Fioctric Veng without permission. He personally consultod me whether there is incorvenionce to start construction, I told hin ocur intention to make it permanont and allowed hin to do. Hence he started construction. I beg your parclon on this.

The responsibility of Finance Department regarding Expenditure Control is like this:Grants for various Dopartments is passed by vote in this Legislative Assenbly, and the Finance Department should sce whether they are using it as it is supposed to be. The Grant was Lurp-sum, and the detailed expenditure is the rosponsibilitics of each of the Department Foads. Tho Finance Department have to see whether each of the Deprement Hearl use the Grant as it should bc.

( Pu Lalsangzuala: Does j.t not contradict Ruine party President's \%int that those who consurner more Petrol worked nore ?) Wo requested the Contral Governvent to lift Economic cut rogarcin; plan and Dovolonment which may be curbed, but the repily is not yot recoivon. We hope they shall allow us. accorcint to tinoir oral answor. We nay have consuned ruch zetrol $2 s$ it may be necessary, we shall try to cconomise. The Finance Dopartment irepared Rule to regulate use of Vehiclo and consumption of ictrol, on 5th September, 1972; Which was circulated to various Departments in the month of Fobruary, 1973. We don't know further how they eqplied, as it is not the futy, just a Government ordor. The Deportment Honde are responsible for this.

Mis-usc of Vchicles by kinisters was montiono, I lonmed that when linisters use Government Vehiclos for 1 rivate jur ose they paill the rate fixed by the Govemment, I myself pic. Sis-use of Cars by Ministers was ofton mentioned. If you look at soction 6, Clause (C) 3 of solvies and Allowneos Bill, passech sone lays ago, Soaker, wo Sieaker ant wisters, furing one guarter of Year can use inisterial Cars at 5 riles ( 8 KM .) distanco from Station where they cannot bilil T. As. During one month 600 Kr . is fixed to be coverer by vinisters' Cars. If that exccer they shoul. jay the hire rate of staff Car. Ministors don't over. uso that much, I want to tol. this fouse that tho pinisters rathor use half their allotiment. Thank you.

Syeaker Sir, We don't expect thom to function like 100 years old states, we exiect then to function as one yoar and 5 months old Ministry.) Their expecting us to function like cre Year and 5 months rinistry is too much, they are oxpecting us to do all and everything, they are asking where have we done development ! We are just beginning $d$ Mal-Adrinistration cannot yct be aade, complain may be made, even when we investigated reports action will be too heavy for the fault, oven when we investigated the report that a certain Governaent have 2 wrivate Motors, no Mbtor Vehicle is in his own nome. There are rany meanineless sound which comilicated thines.

As our Government Officers and Staff have morenaterials I expect they shall work faster Yestorday, one bibor saic the workers are plenty while there is no work, but it will be difficult to do work without workers. sunpose I intend to work without workers, inporting machines, but someone will have to do the work of fetchine. I want you to uncerstand the difficulties we met. We are careful rocarding apointment trying to be neutral, our Mizo. "Why should not I favour sore ? Should I not favour those who try to uplift re, than those who try to degrade me ?" I rocomenren whon I favoured, we all recomender, I comit n mistoke which you also comrit.

In sone Denartment we shall not make much proeress, for instance foclical jepartment. We irmortod 7 Doctors fron other states they fled hone because they were frichtoned at the date of $i .0 \mathrm{~s}$ and lootinc. We 1 resently offer 11 iosts of Doctors from other. States, I don't know whether they shajl cone or not. As Doctors are insufficient, senior Nurses shall have to look after some dispensarics. Wo decided to post them even where Doctors
are jresent, than abanionin indue to aissence of Doctors. We don't have conoth Corpuncers, it is jrobalole that we shall haro to post senior Nurses in ajsence of Corrounders. I want you to understand the ifficultics we net due to our not hevine engueh experioncod men.

We see how our Govermment have progressed, for tinose who have not scon dizawl, they may think it to louk like Jericho, thou;h we have not actually soen what Joriko was like. Aizawl is develop by Crach Schene, if we hed nct chone it so, rrogross will be çhecked. In vartous Daces, veri us Dopartnents are enlarged. We have to find better way of Cultivation, it seems we concentrate on Terrace Cultivation more than past years. We dare not yet do it greatly thinking whether it shall be successful or not. If it comes out unsuceesful wo shall ruin the land. Now, as Pu Saprawnga said the experiment appears to be successful from the example of paddy field where it was practice. We shall make it bigger, which shall be insufficient; we have to think whether we shall turn to Horticulture or other way.

We have to think whether we shall orperiment the practice of Chin Hills dividing into 2 Blocks. growing corn wherc rice falles and start eating Atta ? Location of Industry have to be considered: sufficient water is nceded and the condition of tho workers have to be considcred along with communication, what and how shall we do ? Enquiry Committee with have to be formed to enquire into such case". $A_{s}$ he requested as so and that Enquiry Committee shall heve to be formeci to enquire into corruption, yet such Committoe is not yet formed and we have no alternative other than this.

I would like to reply some short points mentioned earlier, Pu Saitlawna saicl " Pu J.Thanghuama, boing Chairmen of the P.A.C. should have reserved this for other time, he clocs what he ought not tic do', but the P.A.C. cannot holcl emergency mecting, the mis-expencliture of Mizoram will be auditalater by the Aocomntant General Staff, we sheill know after receiving roport and consiter it later on. Hon'ble Member Pu Saprawnga pointed out other States as example, regarcing corruption, whether corruption is rampant or not in other States does not concern the welfare of Mizoram, but his pointing out Eor example makes we think that therc is someting bolling inside him and may be he has connection in the corruption practices. Pu Vantalhruaia pointed out the progross of Crash Scheme in Mission Veng, saying it was meant for the carning of livelihcod for the poors, which we appreciate. We question the emergency of construction of road between Mr.F.C. Nghina's house and Mission Vong. The procedure is wrong, there is no estimate. it is possible to make estimate accorilng to the general procedure; the residence of Director of Education is about to slide, but intention to put under Crash Scheme is not yet made. We criticise only that much, we don't say working is unnecessary.

Mr.Spoaker Sir, I want to make appeal to you regarding our proceedings of yesterday and today, I want All Inclia Ranio to know that I am not satisfied with the manner of news broadcasting and I request you to tell them this: If they are to release tonight the proceerings of todiay let them announce the admission of all the opposition regardit Malmikinistration and Corruption of the Ruling Party. They cannot say cven-a single charge we made as lie. In England Constitution Convention is important, recently one Minister got involved in a Scantal regarding call Girl, ant having Moral obligation he resigned. Moral cbligratinn should be shown rogar ?ing these Corruption practices printen sut, the Finance Ministers' issue of 3 Permits prior to having' Excise net is worth the point for resignation. Ne con't mean the other Ministers shoulr resign, we just mean they strayed arl sid wrong things to resign; we are sorry that Moral obligation is nil. The Ministry don't deny all our charcjes and amonder all, yet it still romains silent regarding lissolution. It is unwelcome news to hear.

We gremble. at our stancling Government though we cince not say ali the 200 Primary Teachers we appointer were fit, but in order to console some and the

Our Ministry prepares 5 Year Plan and work clays and nights and contacts Delhi many times, in which they don't consult the opponent Party. Even when VIPs visits us, they never consulted us to have talks with them, we know their proce?ure after they loft. From all these points I conclude they don't need our help. We are not responsible for their undischoserl actions and 1 hope they will understand if we criticise them.
wouse Tho whole of Mizoram feee famine, much moreathan whilc we wore unler Assam Government. We clon't bleme our Ministry for the past, as that was beyond their scope and power; but even after having our own Ministry the past mal-practices, instead of checking it, are morc rampant as if encouraged. The Comtral Government cares us tonderly ane provide sufficiont provision, but $50 \%$ of those are in the hends of some pooplc while only tho other half are sherer hy the poople. These makes me fecl angry.

Think of our Union Territory Government: Construction of scme buileings are going on in A1zawl, Officcs are beautifully furnished like Director of Supply and Transport office. We too visited Offices of other Statis like Negaland cte. our mothod hero is not to be fount elsowherc. While wo aro enfoying luxurious life, the Genoral people who lift us to this position are stricken by famine, they cen't find even labour work and don't know what they shall cat tomerrow.

In tho Mizo Union Parliamentary Mcoting presicol over by Pu Vaivenga, on 12 May, hon'ble Momber Iu Saprawnga said about the Ministry as "It is like a stagnant wetor" Mr.Spoaker Sir, shall I mention the names of the concorned porsons ? ( Pu Ch. Saprawnga: Mr. Syoaker sir, I was not present at the meeting.) Don't cheny, we know all about your committcc. Some of the Ruling Mombers appociate this Motion. Why don't we bravely stan? fast for whet wo loarner to be true? Why are you going te leny your decision outside the House by Vote of Demand that 4 if the Minjstry will not resign we ourselves will resign", Aro we not going to stand fast bravely for truth ?

While the people of Mizoram are
facing famine, in some cor-ner hundreds and thoulands of quintal of Rice are left rotten. The Minister-1n-charge cannot hold his post, he should resign. If the Central Government had not provided rice and money, we can understand, but rice is provided why do we let people starved ? The brother of Supply Minister is a Contractor of Mamit, after sufficient supply was sent, excess 800 2uintals of rice was allotted for Phaileng and Lallen Villeges, which was sold outside the Government fixed rate and we lost about Rs. $4.88,000 /$ - or so for the cost of Transport. Ranjit Porter P. H. E.Contractor, of Karimganj, got contract under P. H.E. without Tender being-called and we lost around Rs.2/- lakhs for this. The Villagers of Valrengte draw Rs.6,000/- or so for Soil. Plantation, though Grant is never sanctioned for the kind of work. It was reported that Mizoram Forest wools are takon to Silchar ancl sold at high price, and Divisiobal Forest Officer was sent to detect, but where is the report ? Let's not devastate our Forest any more, while we get about Rs. 1 lakhs as profit, millions of Rupees are in Somcbody's hands.

Whd issucd Completion Certificate to Tipaimuk Forest Guard Quarter ? Rs. $13,500 /-$ was taken as Arlvances. The D.F.O. Quarter area near Lungremsei slided, the estimate for construction was Rs. $15,000 /-$, I have not mentioned this carlier as I found it not just this morning, Rs. 21,500/- was the total Bill for construction, but where have all the stones gone?

* Saha Engineering supplied us Tools and Gears, and we lost Rs. 2,25,000/-. Aizawl-Thenzawl Road, Scction 4 was contracted by one person, which was estimated at Rs. $1,66,000 /-$, in which he draw Rs. $6,000 /-$ when, Advance Measurement was taken. Many Government servants are Contractors, which Conduct Rules prohibits, how can they be allowed to Contract ? If wo cannot follow the Rules let us pormit Government servants, the Alrect depandants to contract. The Minister-incharge should see the Registration Book and publish cancellation. The Ministry don't follow Rules, we don't blame ncither the Departments nor Officers, we bleme the Ministry. According to our Rules, Ifome Minister makes mistake the whole Ministry is collectivgly responsibie? hence we blame the wholc Ministry for one Minister's fault, so it should resign collectively.

If they don't intend to resign or wo connot make them resign, wo will not be satisfid since they admitted all our cherges, and yet they don't intent to take action we shall report to the Contral Government. If wo cannot make this Ministry resign for our No-Confidence Motion, we shall such other way, like reporting to C.B.I. Now the Ministry knows all its weak points and I want it to accept the way. we want, but till today none of such is fulfilled. Swopers worc appointed, how many swepers are loitoring? They to whatovor they liked an? draw salaries at the ond of the month. Did we pass the Budget for that purpose ? The existing Ministry exists to represcnt the poople of Mizoram, yet the poors are becoming poorer, while only fow peonle like Ministors' relatives;M. L.As, Party men who are close relatives etc. are profiter? they become richor and richer and run unhealthy race which results in nociectful and luxurious wey of life. Is the Ministry ignorant of all these ? No, if so, why foes not it try to improve it ?

The Retailer of Kolasib risposed
572 Quintals of Rice, 65 Quintals of Sugar, supplich for the public. Whore are those supplies ? The Village Council Mombers and the cjencral public wanted to have talk with the hon'ble Chief Minister, on his return journcy from Delhi, but they could not meet him; the Chief Minister went alrectly to the fouse of the Retailer an? ate delicious food. What clis the Retailcr say? He announced that even if he were susponied, it will do him no harm, as his 'Master' shall save him. He was bailod immo iatcly, ant still work as Kolnsib Retailer till today. What is the meaning ? We ron't oxpoct the Ministry to be perfect, as no man is perfect, cerruntion an? means of baministration carried out by the Ministry which we nointer out are loss than $50 \%$, we exnect the Ministry to take action on what we said, as we dirl this ayour roquest, but if you will do nothing it is bad for us.

Mochanical Divisicn was created anc locntce somewherc, but nono of Governmet Motor Vehicles are repaired there as they are all entrusted to Private Workshop. If so, for whet purposo the Mechanical Division is croatcd ? In Agriculture Department, D.F.C. Is practiced, somobody'spon supercecter his seniors. Just because he is the son $n f$ an important person in the Acriculture Departmont, ho supercered his seninr. Seniority class efficiency are igncree. If only the well-to-do familics are to survive, filyincs over the powner classes, we will be dissatisfied at our Ministry's way of lealing us.

Trade Licence was issued by the Ministry which was Cancelled, it was given for a long period, which was extended after expiry. We contwacted Home Ministerg K.C.Pant regarding M.N.F. Returnees Renabilitation, I think the Ministry too mot him, Mr.K.C. Pant said they warted to Rehabilitate M.N. F. Returnees as early as possible. The Ministry don't think of rehabilitating M. N. F. Returnees. it satisfies itself with the giving of ks. 200/- or more to cach at the time of thoir surrenter. Regarding Law and Order we can't help charging the Ministry with no intention to promote and bring about Peace and Security in Mizoram. Even though we mentioned our condition while under Assam Goverment the Ministry ial not respinsible for that we now look to our condition since having our own Ministry. Have we sought for the formula and principle to fimprove the bad practices while we werc under Assam Govermment ? Have we sought fin the formula why we faced famines every consecutive year ? We have mentionocl all sorts of eorruption, have we
sought for a formula to stop it ? Though nobody goes round Vanlaiphai, somebody billad as going round and Government lost some lakhs of Rupees. That was known. What action has been takon ? We are not satis fied with the aiministration of the Ministry. Here we can enjoy luxuricus way of life, heving Cars ancl livincs in luxurious Bungalows, with sufficient food supply, but are the people who lifted them to these positions happy ? No, they don't have rice and other supplies. Thinking of theme, it is necessary to pull down the Ministry to save Mizoram while there is time. Moral obligation should be shown. The Ministry cannot counter act all our charges, but if rothing is going to be done to imerove the condition of Mizoram, it should not be called lend of the Christians.

In the Central India corruption may be rampant as population is thick, nobody knows who his neighbours. In Mizorm, not to speak of neighbours, we know each other very well. It is possible for us to set Model Government, worth copying for other States. But there is no intention to set such cxample, our Ministers, as if having no work, loiter and chat conlessly. There is no intention to check out P.W.D. Contrectors reports, or sanction off Cash aftor completion, or are there really any Goverrment servants is Contractors etc ? Action is not taken, though they notor? cicwn all what we said, it will. vanish easily. I am afraid there will be nothing done.

The pconle of Mizorem are now mourning when there is advertisement of any vacent posts. hundreds of candidates appearet. Why do we want to hold Goverment Service and dosporately long for it ? Have they soucght out how a Governmont Servant can be satisfied at his station just as farmors and business mon can bo satisfiod in their respoctive stations ?

Visit the Villagers, what are their conitions ? It is unpleasant to sec them, they have nothing to ent, in my Constituency even Atta is not available. Herc we have overy thinc; yet we ignore our people.

Someriay, God's grace will stop, he will not like to sec us who are to look for the welfare of the people but ignore them. Thank you, Mr.Speaker, for giving me more time.

Mr.Speaker Sir, the word "toying or playing" was said Un-Parifamentary. Let him plase explain how he use it.
( Eu J.Thanghuame: It is unnecessary.) If so, he spoke Un-Parliamentaryan.

Mr. Spenker Sir, the Opposition
Leader accused us of admitting all
their charges against us.
(Sponker : I shall roaci the Rulos) (Pu J.Thanghuama:It is urnecessary to read out) (Members cheer and clapped hands.) (Sponker: Is it unnccessary to read out ?) They may be too eagor to say of us admitting their charges. We just said we shall onquire into it; even yestersay's questions arc incluced, so also your charges against us. Regareting this Mbtion, we are not compelled to answers all your Qucstions, because it is not Questions. Hour. (Pu J. Thanchuama: We aske? specific points and you shoula roply all our charges ajainst you, for instance, we charged whether it is a fact that the Finance Minister issucd 3 Dermits prior to passing of Excise Bill ? If that is not truc, let it be that we lie). There are many thinge we have not heard yet, which are to be enquired into, our Members roplicd your charges yestcrelay and this morning, we don't almit your charges. Thoy solct 'Wo will be satisfled if they thensclves enquired into them for us. Which is our alm',

which we promised to do as best we could. You wanted me to relly tonay or tomorrow or somerlay, which was not replied, though it is a question it is not compulsory to reply. You shoula have charger us on our faults, but their charging us for what they themsclvos don't know is meaningless. Their charics being so, we kcep it penting. (Members clapped hants). It is wrong of him to say we admit all their charges against us, this rominds me of last year's incident. He seid Mizo Union M.L.As appreciate our No-Confidence Motion. Why deny it now ? which I think is wrong and don't accept as truth. Supposc we accept as truc, such is the condition. It may be due to difference of ideas. It was mentioned earlier, during incomplete 2 Years in the District Councll, we reshuffled 4 times when they got majority. As such rosignation is infavourable, as they may crush us to death. If they take up the Ministry, I am afraid they shall disagree within 2 months and disperse, they are impatient. If they had perscrvetance arrangoment can be made easily in a Party. No-Confidence Motion moved by one Party against itself is rare, yet they moved against themselves. Their moving agcinst us is right, but their moving against thenselves is unhealthy for a mature man to take part. (Members clapped hands) We cannot resign out of fear that they may hold the Ministry. ( Pu J.Thanghuma: Mr.Speaker Sir, they are about to muve No-Confidence motion against themselves.) It may perheps be 50 in the future. (Pu Hrangaia: Pu Thanghwama will still qrumble even in Heaven!) If such ever happen, we shall reshuffle ourselves and resume work as if nothing harmened. I think we will not have the nerve to do as they did, so I decided to holl on, we are afraid they will think of ue as the worst. Wo tried our best to promote Peace and Security, as wo said yestorday, it is necessary to carefully consicier the condition of cur M.N.F. brothers, we don't say we shell not rchabilitatc our M.N.F. Returnees who surrendered uncer Amesty period; we aro planning bigger Scheme as difinicultios may arise. I beg pardon, thare are many who lost lives in the hends of M.N.F. and Security Forces and who cannot live peacefully in their own Homes. There are other wollnto-dos who never dreamt of labpuring to earn their dinily foon, but now labouring hard, In order to aviod crisis wo propiscri to lift grouping of villages, and to consider rohebilitating of the M.N.F. Returnees. The last time I visited Prime Minister I left a demand that we shall need at least Rs. 5 crores to rehabilitate those driven out from thrir homes, which the Prime Minister replied as suggesting cur planning of proper schemes. As looting and killing is rampant again it stands in the way of the Scheme. Let us face the fact together and we may be able to develop the country. Why shall wo be ignorant of our weak points ?

Why don't we want to see the difficulties in devotion? Security is the main point. We the rivos are responsible for this disturbance. We should not think each other as ignorine our Underyround brothers, we show preferences to them as best we could, we said just because they are M. N.F. they should not be deprived of this right if they apply for any post. Thercfore, it is wrong to assume that wo nogiect Mov. T. Returnees, but it may not be satisfactor,r Will wo be able to satisfy all ?, this is a big question. We don't ignore them in general, somebody is expert in encouraging others to creatc misunderstanding between two parties. Anyhov, we still survive by the Grace of Almighty God.

We are beginning to progress in Devilopment work, staff and other workers will sure make prospess. It is not that we admit all their charges against us, we aill not hositate to veriry all that can be enquire into.

We are discussing the motion on ral-administration carried out by the innistry, if the House no longer trust the inistry, as it depends on the Housc, they should resign, if the Houso still trust the linistry it shall stand. you mean Division ? Division snculd be latter, if we are not satisfied with the first one. The usual practice is Veice Vote, but now we shall make it to count Votes. Now we shali boar your ideas regarding the motion.
(Pu Saitlama: ir. Speaker sir, we requested hin to with(2raw, please ask him about that.) Some Meribers asked to withraw it, let the nover say his ideas. Pu J.Thanghana ir. Speaker sir, not to mention withclrawal, I demand secret Bollot, Vote will be different. Don't feel safe in the iouso, you con't havo people, don't depend on the people) It's enouth. (Pu Soitlawa: Ir. Speaker Sir, I an afreit they will lone for the time prior to their movine) I shall road out tho aotion and take vote "This House expresses its wint of Confidence in the Ministry led by Shri Ch. Chinuen for the following ronsons - Mal-administration in ilizorari". Those of you who have no trust in the Kinistry, ploase stend up. ( 6 Opposition Members stixd up). Those who still have trust in the linistry
please stand up. (loribers stood and clapped hands). I shall announce the sesult of the Vote, the Motion "This House expresses its want of Confidence in the Rinistry led by Shri Ch. Chhuna for Ml-administration in Mizoran" was supported by 6 Members, 26 Members still have trust in the Ministry who wins, so the motion is lost.
( Pu J.Thanghuana : Now, Secret Ballot ?) It.'s nearly 5 P.M. now, we shall meet again at 11 A.M tomorrow. We shall be able to take up our pending Bill.
