SPEAKER : Now that a Motion of Thanks has been proposed by Pu Joe Ngurdawla, any Member who wishes to second the proposal may do so.

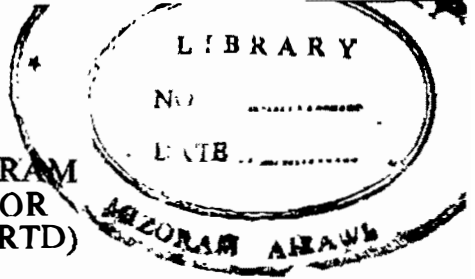
PU BIAKCHHUNGA : Pu Speaker, I hereby second the proposal of Pu Joe Ngurdawla on Motion of Thanks.
