

PROCEEDINGS OF THE EIGHT & BUDGET SESSION OF THE THIRD
MIZORAM LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY SESSION HELD FROM
11TH MARCH TO 26TH MARCH, 1982

1ST SITTING ON 11TH MARCH, 1982.

Dr. Kenneth Chawngliana, Speaker at the Chair, Chief Minister, four Ministers and 17 Members were present.

ADDRESS BY THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR

MOTION OF THANKS

3. Pu Joe Ngurdawla, MLA to move a motion of thanks on the Lieutenant Governor Address.

SPEAKER : I call upon Pu Joe Ngurdawla to move Motion of Thanks. Do we all have a copy of it ?

PU JOE NGURDAWLA : Pu Speaker, I am very glad that the Lieutenant Governor have addressed the House. He has brought us many good news. He has said how budget provision was utilised in 1981—82 and how we are going to utilise our provision Rs. 29 crores in 1982—83. We shall discuss it in detail. My motion is this : "That a members of the Mizoram Legislative Assembly assembled in this Session are deeply grateful to the Lieutenant Governor for the Address which he has been pleased to deliver to the Assembly on the 5th March, 1982". I ask for permission to discuss it.

PU L. PIANDENGA : Pu Speaker, I second Pu Joe Ngurdawla's Motion.

SPEAKER : Pu Joe Ngurdawla has moved Motion of Thanks and was seconded by L. Piandenga. A copy of the Address was received by all the Members. Let us all read it thoroughly and we shall open time for discussion on the Address as asked for the time of which will be announced later.

There is one announcement. More members have submitted in writing their intention to attend the celebration of Thlawhbawk Liberation Day. This means there will be no quorum in the House. As such the House will be adjourned till 10:30 A.M. on 15th March, 1982 (Monday) as provided under Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business, Mizoram Legislative Assembly Rules 15.

PU J. THANKUNGA : Pu Speaker, there is one thing specially gratifying in the Lieutenant Governor Address today. I would like to make a request because of this. About one third of the total population of Mizoram, who have been declared as thlawhbawks since the last part of 1966 till 1982, who have never enjoyed a life of freedom as permanent villages and constantly threatened by some people that they are not going to have village councils have been liberated and accepted by the Government of India as permanent villages. To celebrate their liberty I request a public holiday be declared for tomorrow.

Besides, it is a Memorable day in Mizo History. So, if it can be declared a State Government Holiday, We must be grateful to the hon'ble Prime Minister Mrs. Indira Gandhi who made this liberation possible. I would request you to join me with "Long Live" when I say Mrs. Indira Gandhi. Now let us start, Mrs. Indira Gandhi (Members-Long live). We ought to be grateful to the P.C. Ministry which has paved the way for thlawhbawk liberation. I shall say "P.C. Ministry" and I request the members to please continue it by "long live" (They did). Lastly, but not least, the most responsible person for thlawhbawk liberation is our hon'ble Chief Minister Brig. T. Sailo, who has spared nothing to convince the Central Government the necessity of liberating thlawhbawks. Let us all say "long live" to his name as we did his Ministry.

SPEAKER : The House was supposed to be adjourned after Lieutenant Governor Address and Motion of Thanks. However, I gave special permission to Pu J. Thankunga to say a few words as there was a very good news for all of us, which deserves to be celebrated by the whole territory. We shall adjourn the House. Before that, I give permission to make announcement.

CHIEF MINISTER : BRIG. T. SAILO. Pu Speaker, an hon'ble member has made a request, Had not we better confirm it by others raising their hands?

SPEAKER : Pu J. Thankunga has made request to the Chief Minister to declare tomorrow a public holiday to celebrate thlawhbawk liberation. Any member who agrees to the request may please raise your hands. (Pu Hiphei : Are we going to do what was not included in the list of business?) No. I gave him special permission. (Members raise their hands) We all agree to it, Will the Chief Minister announce it now?

CHIEF MINISTER : BRIG. T. SAILO. Pu Speaker, I respect the wish of all members. Let us have a holiday tomorrow. (Members applauded).

SPEAKER : All right, tomorrow is a holiday. We shall celebrate Thlawhbawk Liberation. House is adjourned till 10:30 A.M. on Monday.
