NOTIFICATION

No.A.I2018/18/2016-P&AR(GSW), the 26th February, 2018. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules to amend the Mizoram Health Service Rules, 2009, namely:-

1. *Short title and commencement*
 - (1) These rules may be called the Mizoram Health Service (Amendment) Rules, 2017
 - (2) They shall come into force from the date of publication in the Mizoram Gazette

2. *Amendment of rule 5*

Sub-rule (3) and (4) of rule 5 of the Mizoram Health Service Rules, 2009 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules) shall be substituted by the following, namely;

“(3) Each Sub-Cadre shall have the following grades:

 - a) GDMO, Dental Surgeon and AYUSH Sub-Cadres:
 - i) Grade-I
 - ii) Grade-II
 - iii) Grade-III
 - b) Specialist, Public Health and Dental Specialist Sub-Cadres:
 - i) Grade-I
 - ii) Grade-II
 - c) Super Specialist Sub-Cadre:
 - i) Grade-I

(4) Above Grade-I in all the Sub-Cadres, there shall be three higher grades viz. Selection Grade, Supertime Grade ‘B’ and Supertime Grade ‘A’ which does not belong to a particular Sub-Cadre”

3. *Amendment of sub-rule (1) of rule 15*

Sub-rule (1) of rule 15 of the Principal Rules shall be substituted as follows, namely;

“The relative seniority of members of the service in General Duty Medical Officer Sub Cadre, Dental Sub Cadre and AYUSH Sub

Provided that all promotions shall be made strictly as prescribed in Schedule-V of these rules;

Provided further that members of the Service belonging to various Sub-Cadres except in the Selection Grade and Supertime Grades may be considered for non-functional promotion within their respective Sub-Cadre to the next higher Grade without linkage to vacancies to ensure quality in service after completion of 6 (six) years of regular service in Grade-III and 8 (eight) years of regular service in Grade-II;

Provided also that by virtue of this provision, they shall not be entitled to the benefits of existing Assured Career Progression Scheme, by whatever name it is known;

Provided that promotion to the Selection Grade of Mizoram Health Service shall be made on the basis of a combined eligibility list of Officers in Grade-I from all Sub Cadres to be prepared with reference to the dates of completion of the requisite qualifying service by Officers in Grade-I of the Mizoram Health Service and for the purpose of preparation of the combined eligibility list, the eligibility criteria for promotion as prescribed in Schedule-V of these rules shall be followed;

Provided further that a member of the service, irrespective of those who acquired Graduate degree or Post Doctoral Degree/Post Graduate Degree/Post Graduate Diploma, before commencement of the Principal Rules shall be allowed non-functional promotion to Grade II and Grade-I of MHS, as the case may be, on completion of 6 (six) years of regular service in Grade-III and 8 (eight) years of regular service in Grade-II of the Service. However, monetary benefit for retrospective non-functional promotion prior to commencement of the Principal Rules shall not be given"

8. *Amendment of Schedules*

In the Principal Rules, Schedule I, II, III, IV and V shall be substituted as follows, namely;

The method of recruitment, the field of selection for promotion including the minimum qualifying service in the immediate lower grade or lower grades, as the case may be, for appointment or promotion to the posts in the respective Sub-Cadres concerned of the Mizoram Health Service shall be as prescribed hereunder.

Supertime Grade 'B' (Director of Health Services)	Promotion by selection method	Officers in Selection Grade from GDMO Sub-Cadre or Public Health Sub-Cadre with 5 (five) years regular service in the grade failing which Officers in Selection Grade from GDMO Sub-Cadre or Public Health Sub-Cadre who have completed 20 (twenty) years of regular service calculated from the date of entry to the duty posts of MHS out of which at least 2 (two) years of regular service in Selection Grade Notwithstanding the eligibility conditions mentioned above, Officers in Selection Grade from GDMO Sub-Cadre or Public Health Sub-Cadre who have completed 20 (twenty) years of regular service calculated from the date of entry to the duty posts of MHS out of which at least 2 (two) years of regular service in the Special Grade in PB-3 ^ 15,600-39,100 + ^ 7,600GP before the commencement of these rules shall be eligible for the next two vacancy years i.e. till 2019-20
3.	Supertime Grade 'B' (Director of Hospital & Medical Education)	Promotion by selection method	Officers in Selection Grade from Specialist Sub-Cadre or Super Specialist Sub-Cadre with 5 (five) years regular service in the grade failing which Officers in Selection Grade from Specialist Sub-Cadre or Super Specialist Sub-Cadre who have completed 20 (twenty) years of regular service calculated from the date of entry to the duty posts of MHS out of which at least 2 (two) years of regular service in Selection Grade. Notwithstanding the eligibility conditions mentioned above, Officers in Selection Grade from Specialist Sub-Cadre or Super Specialist Sub-Cadre who have completed 20 (twenty) years of regular service calculated from the date of entry to the duty posts of MHS out of which at least 2 (two) years of regular service in the Special Grade in PB-3 ^ 15,600-39,100 + ^ 7,600GP before the commencement of these rules shall be eligible for the next two vacancy years i.e. till 2019-20
4.	Selection Grade	100% promotion in the form of financial upgradation on the basis of selection method	Officers in Grade-I from all the Sub Cadres listed in Rule 5 with not less than 18 years of regular service from the date of entry into the duty posts of MHS OR with not less than 16 years of regular service from the date of entry into the duty posts of MHS in Grade-II (Specialists/Public Health/ Dental Specialist Sub Cadres) with Post Graduate Diploma OR with not less than 15 years of regular service from the date of entry into the duty posts of MHS in Grade-II (Specialists/Public Health/ Dental Specialist Sub Cadres) with Post Graduate Degree OR with not less than 12 years of regular service from the date of entry into the duty posts of MHS in Grade-I (Super Specialists Sub Cadre) with Post Doctoral Degree, whichever is the earliest.
