**PROGRAMME OF GOVERNOR ADDRESS TO ASSEMBLY ON 13TH
MARCH, 2007.**

1. Members are informed that as provided in sub-rule (1) of Rule 17 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in Mizoram Legislative Assembly, the governor will address the Assembly on Tuesday, the 13th March, 2007 at 10:30 A.M.
2. Members are requested to be in their seats in the Assembly Hall by 10:25 A.M on the 13th March, 2007.
3. On arrival at the Gate of Assembly House the Governor will be received by the Speaker and the Secretary of the Assembly. Thereafter, the Governor will be conducted to the Assembly Hall in procession in the following order:

Assembly Marshall and ADC to Governor
Secretary
Governor and Speaker
Marshall will lead the procession and announce entry of His Excellency the Governor in the House.
4. All Members will rise as soon as the announcement is made. With the Governor reaching his seat on the dais the M.A..P Band Party will play the NATIONAL ANTHEM. Thereafter, the members and visitors in the galleries resume their seats.
5. The Governor will then address the House.
6. At the conclusion of the Address, the Governor may resume his seat for a few seconds. The Governor again rises and National Anthem will be played by M.A..P. Band Party. Then the Governor leaves the House.
7. After the governor leaves, Member will resume their seats for transaction of Business of the House as per List of Business for the day.
