1. Starred Questions

Starred Questions Nos. 34, 36, 37, 38, 39 and 40 with Supplementaries thereto were orally answered. Starred Questions Nos. 35 listed for the day was not answered as the member in whose name the question stood was absent.

2. Unstarred Questions

Replies to Unstarred Questions Nos. 7, 8 and 9 were laid on the Table.

3. Private Member's Bill

Pu K.Lalsanga moved that "The Mizoram Board of School Education (Amendment) Bill, 1981" be taken into consideration.

Amendment was moved by Pu F.Malsawma, Minister for Education.

On a motion moved by Pu k.Lalsanga, incharge of the Bill, the Bill was passed unanimously in an amended form.

4. Private Members' Resolution

“This Assembly is of the opinion that the present Circuit House at Silchar be called ‘Mizoram House’ in the interest of the public.”

“This Assembly is of the opinion that Pachhunga University College must be taken back from N.E.H.U. and be placed under direct administration of the Government of Mizoram at an early date.”

Pu C.L. Ruala moved again an amendment in the following form:-

“This Assembly resolves that necessary steps be taken by the Government of Mizoram to take back Pachhunga University College, Aizawl from N.E.H.U. and placed it under the direct administration of the Government”.
