1. Starred Questions: Starred questions Nos. 61 to 67 with supplementaries thereto were orally answered.

2. Government Bill-Introduction:

Under Rule 69 (3) of the Rules of Procedure the Hon'ble Speaker allowed Pu R.Thangliana, Finance Minister to introduce "The Mizoram District (Land and Revenue) (Amendment) Bill, 1976." On permission being given, the Bill was introduced. The Speaker announced that the Bill would be taken up for consideration on Tuesday, the 30th March, 1976.

3. Voting on Demands for Grants for 1976-77:

Pu Ch. Chhunga, Chief Minister moved Demands Nos. 2, 14, 16, 17, 19, 21, 29, 32, 33, 35 and 49 in respect of various Departments under his charge.

The leave was granted and the Bill (Bill No. 2 of 1976) was introduced.

The motion was adopted and the Bill was passed unanimously.
