1. Starred Questions:

Starred Questions Nos. 7, 8 and 9 with supplementaries thereto was orally answered.

2. Private Members' Resolutions:

(i) Pu Saplina moved the following Resolution:-

“This Assembly recommends to the Government of Mizoram to take early steps to make the River Chhimtuipui navigable by means of Lock-Gate system at the most suitable point for the purpose of industrial and Agriculture development of the region.”

On the request made by Pu ch.Chhunga, Chief Minister to withdraw his Resolution and permission, having been granted by the House, Pu Saplina withdrew his Resolution.

(ii) Pu R.Dotinaia moved the following Resolution:-

“This Assembly is of the opinion that a new Capital of Mizoram Union Territory be set up and for that a Commission be constituted to select a suitable site.”

Member Pu Ngurdawla expressed his opinion that this yet too early for use to think.

Pu Ch. Chhunga, Chief Minister joined the discussion, and on his request, and permission having been granted by the House, the resolution was withdrawn.

3. Private Member’s Resolution not moved:

Under sub-rule (2) of Rule 125 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Mizoram Legislative Assembly, the Resolution No. 2 stood withdrawn as the mover was absent.
