1. Starred Questions:

Starred Questions listed for the day (Nos. 29, 30, 31, 32 and 33) with supplementaries thereto, were orally answered.

2. Letter from Lt. Governor (Administrator):

The Hon'ble Speaker read out to the House the letter received from the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator) conveying his thanks to the Speaker and to the House for the Vote of Thanks on his Address.

3. General Discussion on the Budget:

The following Minister took part concluding the General discussion on the Budgets:-

- (1) Pu Ch. Chhunga, Chief Minister
- (2) Pu Vaivenga, Education Minister
- (3) Pu R.Thangliana, Development Minister
- (4) Pu K.T.Khuma, Finance Minister.

4. Report of the Business Advisory Committee:

The Speaker presented the 5<sup>th</sup> Report of the Business Advisory Committee recommending the change in the time for commencement of the sittings to 10:00 A.M. instead of the usual time of 11:00 A.M. on Thursday, the 28<sup>th</sup> March, 1974 and Friday, the 29<sup>th</sup> March, 1974 only, which was adopted by the House on a motion moved by Pu R.Thangliana, Minister in-charge of Parliamentary Affairs.

5. Voting on Demands for Grants:

The Supplementary Demands for 1973-74 was first taken up, and to enable quicker transaction of business, the Hon.ble Speaker invited the Finance Minister to move the Supplementary Demands for 1973-74 under various Heads. The Finance Minister accordingly moved that Rs. 8,17,85,400/- Under various Demands (listed) be passed. After a short discussion, the Demands were voted and passed.

6. Government Bill-Introduction & Passed:

The Appropriation (No. 1) Bill, 1974 (Assembly bill No. 2 of 1974) was introduced by the Finance Minister in the House, and moved that it be passed. The bill was accordingly passed unanimously.

7. Voting on Demands for Grants for 1974-75:

The Demands Nos. 2, 3, 15, 16, 12 and 20 were moved, discussed and passed unanimously.
