1. Questions:

(a) Starred Question Nos. 31 to 34, 36 to 41 listed for the day with supplementaries thereto were orally answered.

Replies to starred questions Nos. 45 and 46 are being circulated under Rule 37(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

(b) Replies to Unstarred Questions Nos. 5 and 6 were placed on the Table.

2. Announcement of members of Committees:

The Speaker announced names of members for 8 (eight) Assembly Committees for a period of one year from October, 1975 to September, 1976.

3. Private Members' Business:

- (i) Pu Ngurdawla moved the following Resolution (no. 2) in an amended form as follows:

“This Assembly is of the opinion that Mizoram Flowers Garden should be established at the vicinity of Lengpui Grouping Centre or at any other suitable places.”

The following Members took part in the discussion-

- (1) Pu Hrangaia
- (2) Pu Lalhlira

The Resolution was unanimously passed.

- (ii) Under clause (a) of sub-rule (1) of Rule 125 of the Rules of procedure & Conduct of Business in the Mizoram Legislative Assembly, the member in whose name Resolution No. 3 appeared on the Balloted List of Private Members’ Resolutions for 25.9.75 and 26.9.75, declined to move the resolution.

- (iii) Pu Sapliana moved the following Resolution-

“This Assembly is of the opinion that the Government of Mizoram do take steps to move the Government of India to establish and maintain a University College in the Capital of Mizoram as provided for in section 5(14) of the North Eastern Hill University Act, 1973, in the interest of the public.”

The following Members took part in the discussion-

- 2) Pu Ngurdawla
- 3) Pu R.Zoliana

Pu Vaivenga, Minister-in-charge of Education joined the discussion.

The Resolution was unanimously passed.

- (iv) Under clause (a) of sub-rule (1) of Rule 125 of the Rules of Procedure, the member in whose name the Resolutions Nos. 5, 6 and 7 appeared on the Balloted list of Private Members' Resolutions for 25.9.75 and 26.9.75, declined to move the resolutions.
