1. Questions:

- 2. <u>Presentation of Reports</u>:
 - (a) Pu Ch. Saprawnga, Chairman, Committee on Subordinate Legislation presented the First Report of the Committee to the House.
 - (b) Pu C.Lalruata, Chairman, Committee on Government Assurances presented the Fourth Report of the Committee to the House.
- 3. Laying of papers:

Pu P.B.Nikhuma, Deputy Minister Incharge of Health & Family Planning laid "The Rules for Allocation of Seats and Awarding Stipend to Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Trainees" on the Table.

4. Consideration and Adoption of Report:

The Second Report of the Rules Committee was considered and unanimously adopted.

5. <u>Government Bill-Introduction:</u>

Under Rule 29(3) of the Rules of Procedure, the Hon'ble Speaker allowed Pu Ch. Chhunga, Chief Minister, incharge of General Administration Department, to seek permission for introduction of "The Mizoram Urban Areas Rent Control (Amendment) Bill, 1975" (Assembly Bill No. 8 of 1975). On permission being given, the Bill was introduced.

6. <u>Government Bills-Consideration and Passing:</u>

(a) Pu Ch. Chhunga, Chief Minister and Minister-in-charge, Public Works Department moved that "The Mizoram Roadside Land Control Bill, 1975, as reported by the Select Committee, be taken into consideration.

On a motion moved by the Minister-in-charge that the Bill, as reported by the Select Committee, be passed, the Bill was unanimously passed without any amendment.

(b) The Mizoram Trading by Non-Tribals (Regulation) (Amendment) Bill, 1975 was considered.

The Report was adopted on a motion moved by Pu Lalsangzuala, Minister-in-charge of Parliamentary Affairs.
