1. Papers laid on the Table

Pu Zairemthanga laid on the Table a copy each of the following:-

- (i) The Mizoram Detention (Prevention of Black marketing and Maintenance of Supplies of Essential Commodities) Order, 1981.
- (ii) The Mizoram Vehicle (Amendment) Rules, 1981.

2. Discussion & Voting on Supplementary Demands

Pu Lalhmingthanga, Finance Minister moved Supplementary Demands for Rs. 12,50,64,000/- to meet the expenses during the year 1981-82 in respect of the services shown in the Supplementary Demands for Grants for the year 1981-82.
