PROGRAMME OF LT. GOVERNOR'S ADDRESS TO ASSEMBLY ON 20TH MARCH, 1985

1. Members are informed that as provided in rule 16(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in Mizoram Legislative Assembly, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) will address the Assembly on Wednesday, March 20, 1985 at 10:30 A.M.
2. Members are requested to be in their seats in the Assembly Hall by 10:20 A.M. on the 20th March, 1985
3. On arrival at the gate of the Assembly House, the Lt. Governor will be received by the Speaker and the Secretary of the Assembly. Thereafter, the Lt. Governor will be conducted to the Assembly Hall in a procession and his entry will be announced by the Marshall.
4. All Members will rise in their seats as soon as the announcement is made. Then a National Anthem will be played by the Assam Rifles Band Party and the Members resume their seats after the Lt. Governor has taken his seat.
5. The Lt. Governor will then address the House.
6. At the conclusion of the Address, the Lt. Governor will resume his seat for a few seconds. When the Lt. Governor again rises, all members will also rise and remain standing while the National Anthem is played again by the Assam Rifles Band Party. Then the Lt. Governor leaves the Hall in procession.

7. After the Lt. Governor has left, the Members will disperse for ten minutes and then re-assemble in the Assembly Hall for transaction of business of the House as per list of business of the day.

1.	Pu Vanlalnghaka	"This Assembly is of the opinion that a Dam be constructed on the river TLAWNG at Zobawk Kai for the purpose of Picnic Spot-Cum-Fishery."
2.	Pu Lalhmingthanga	"This Assembly is of the opinion that Office of Administrative Officer should be established at Sertlangpui during the year 1985-86."
3.	Pu J. Thanghuama	"This Assembly is of the opinion that Govt. of Mizoram should give top priority to completion of Aizawl-Thenzawl-Lunglei Road."
4.	Pu F. Lalchawna	"This Assembly is of the opinion that Govt. of Mizoram should subsidize the carriage charge of Cement and rapeseed oil for Lunglei and Chhimtuipui Districts at a

		normal rate with effect from 1 st April, 1985.”
5.	Brig. T. Sailo	“This Assembly urges the Govt. of India to speedily and successfully conclude peace talk with representatives of MNF without any further delay.”
