Resolutions

(a) Pu K.BIAKCHUNGNUNGA, before moving his resolution, beg leave of the Speaker to allow him to move his resolution with slight correction of the grammatical mistake that occurred in the resolution published through Bulletin Part II Issue No.62 of 10.3.86. Leave being granted, the resolution was moved as follows-

“In view of the method of implementation of the so-called Land Use Policy of the Government of Mizoram which is detrimental to the economic welfare of the people and the way of pulling financial resources for its implementation from various Government departments creating a great hindrance to the smooth flow of the implementation of departmental programme, this House resolves that the Policy and

implementation of Land Use Policy as practiced in Mizoram should be abandoned immediately.”
