STARRED Question No. 61 to 68 were orally answered with supplementaries thereto.

2. PRIVATE MEMBERS BUSINESS

Resolutions

(a) DISCUSSION on Pu R.Lalawia's resolution part-discussed on Friday, March 14, 1986 resumed. The following members participated in the discussion.

Pu R.Lalawia, mover of the resolution moved to adopt the resolution. The resolution was put to the vote of the House and was negative.

(b) PU J.THANGHUAMA moved the resolution standing in his name as follows-

“This Assembly is of the opinion that any further delay in solving the 20 year long political problems of Mizoram will only create more problems. This Assembly therefore earnestly requests both the Central Government of India and the Mizo National Front delegates (who represent Mizo’s) to resume their talks immediately and thereby arriving at an honourable settlement before the Parliament Budget Session is adjourned sine die.”

Pu Zalawma moved amendment to the resolution moved by Pu J.Thanghuama as follows-

“This Assembly is of the opinion that the present peace talk between the Government of India and the MNF should be successfully concluded immediately.”
