- (a) Whether Rehabilitation Grants sanctioned to the MNF Returnees are payable to all the returnees?
- (b) If not, the reasons thereof;
- (c) If yes, how many returnees had been paid so far and on what rate?
- (d) Is it a fact that those who have returned before 21.1.72 were given only Rs.200/- each?
- (e) If yes, why so much difference from those who returned after 21.1.72?
- (f) What is the total sanctioned amount received from the Central Government for this purpose?
- (g) What is the reason for the grant being disbursed by the Police Department and that also by Police State Headquarters only?
- (h) Will it not be more convenient for the recipient if the grant could be disbursed by the Civil Authorities in each District and Sub-Headquarters?

Lt. Governor's Recommendation regarding Mizoram Appropriation Bill, 1978.

The following communication dated the 21st June, 1978 has been received from the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram:-

"I, N.P. Mathur, Lieutenant Governor (administrator) of the Union Territory of Mizoram, recommend under sub-section (1) of section 23 of the Government of Union Territories Act, 1963 (Central Act 20 of 1963) that the Mizoram Appropriation Bill, 1978 be introduced and moved in the Mizoram Legislative Assembly. I also recommend under sub-section (3) of section 23 of the said Act, the consideration of the said Bill by the Mizoram Legislative Assembly."
