PRIVATE MEMBERS' RESOLUTIONS FOR THE FIRST SESSION OF THE SECOND LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

Five Private Members' Resolutions have been received and admitted by the Speaker. These Resolutions have been balloted as required under Rule 122 of the Rules of Procedure. The following is the relative precedence of the Resolutions.

Sl. No.	Name of Member	Subject
1.	Pu K.Lalsanga	"This Assembly recommends that Mizoram P.W.D. should immediately construct a Road proceeding to Bunglemun Block Centre starting from convenient point on Tuichang-Lokicherra B.R.T.F. Road."
2.	Pu Lalthanzauva	"This Assembly recommends that the Aizawl-Thenzawl-Lunglei Road which is under the Mizoram P.W.D should be taken over by the Border Roads Task Force with immediate effect and made into a Truckable Road."
3.	Pu K.Lalsanga	"This Assembly recommends that suspension bridges be constructed by the Government of Mizoram at- (1) Darzo Fairy in between Hnahthial and Darzo; (2) Over Phairuang river on Thehlelep-Lungsen road; (3) Over De river on Sertlangpui-Lungchem road;

		(4) Over De river on Vuakmual-Thuampui road;
4.	Pu K.Lalsanga	“This Assembly recommends that the Government of Mizoram should construct a Tourist Lodge at Far Park Zawl on Blue Mountain.”
5.	Pu K.Lalsanga	“This Assembly recommends that the BAILEY BRIDGE be constructed by the Government of Mizoram over the river Tlawng in between Lunglei and Haulawng on Aizawl to Lunglei road via Thenzawl.”
