5. Official Resolution

“Whereas in exercise of the power conferred by sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 16 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of the Union Territory of Mizoram has by order issued vide Notification No. DCA/E-176/82/178 dated 9th February, 1983 assumed to himself all the functions and powers vested in, or exercisable by the Lakher District Council with effect from 10th February, 1983.

And whereas under sub-paragraph (3) of the said paragraph 16 the order requires the approval of the Legislative Assembly for its continuance after the expiration of 30 days from the date on which the Legislative Assembly first sits after the issue of the said order:

Now, therefore, it is hereby resolved that this Legislative Assembly do approve the said order of the Lt. Governor (Administrator) issued in the said Notification dated 9th February, 1982.”
