PROGRAMME OF LT. GOVERNOR'S ADDRESS TO ASSEMBLY ON 16TH MARCH, 1983

1. Members are informed that as provided in rule 16(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in Mizoram Legislative Assembly, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) will address the Assembly on Wednesday, March 16, 1983 at 10:30 A.M.
2. Members are requested to be in their seats in the Assembly Hall by 10:20 A.M. on the 16th March, 1983.
3. On arrival at the gate of the Assembly House, the Lt. Governor will be received by the Speaker and the Secretary of the Assembly. Thereafter, the Lt. Governor will be conducted to the Assembly Hall in a procession and his entry will be announced by the Marshall.
4. All Members will rise in their seats as soon as the announcement is made. Then a tape-recorded National Anthem will be played and the Members resume their seats after the Lt. Governor has taken his seat.
5. The Lt. Governor will then address the House.
6. At the conclusion of the Address, the Lt. Governor will resume his seat for a few seconds. When the Lt. Governor again rises, all members will also rise and remain standing while a tape-recorded National Anthem is played again. Then the Lt. Governor leaves the Hall in procession.

7. After the Lt. Governor has left, the Members will disperse for 10 minutes and then re-assemble in the Assembly Hall for transaction of Business of the House as per list of business for the day.
