PRIVATE MEMBERS RESOLUTION FOR THE TWELFTH SESSION OF THE THIRD MIZORAM LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

Eight Private Members Resolutions have been received and admitted by the Hon'ble Deputy Speaker. These Resolutions have been balloted as required under Rule 122 of the Rules of Procedure. The following is the relative precedence of the Resolutions.

1.	Pu H.Rammawi	"This Assembly is of the opinion that for the expeditious and more effective measures, the work of detention and deportation of the unauthorized foreigners from Mizoram which is now in the hands of the Army and BSF be entrusted to the Mizoram Police (MAP/MRP). Also, Mizoram Police Outposts be opened along the International Border at short intervals."
2.	Pu Lal Thanhawla	"This Assembly resolves that new Division

		under the Public Works Department of Government of Mizoram be opened in Champhai Town within this financial year.”
3.	Pu H.Rammawi	“This Assembly is of the opinion that Mizoram Board of Revenue be constituted with a view to formulating source of Revenue under the Government of Mizoram.”
4.	Pu Lalnghaka	“This Assembly is of the opinion that it is high time to increase the remuneration and facilities of the Village Councils, and therefore resolves that- (1) Remuneration of the Village Councils members is enhanced. (2) Recurring grant be given to them in proportion to the size of the Villages.
5.	Pu K.Lalsanga	“This Assembly resolves that a new Hall to be constructed by Government of Mizoram at Lunglei Venglai be named as ‘SAIKUTI HALL.’
6.	Pu H.Rammawi	“This Assembly is of the opinion that the Government should constitute Foreigners Tribunal in each District in Mizoram in order to speed up detection of foreigners.”
7.	Pu Lal Thanhawla	“This Assembly resolves that construction of Champhai-Mimbung Road be started by the P.W.D. of the Government of Mizoram during this financial year.”
8.	Pu Joe Ngurdawla	“This Assembly is of the opinion that remuneration given to members of Village Councils including the Secretaries be increased.”
